CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS OF TABULATION

The tabulated results of a decertification election conducted in the above-captioned matter by an agent of the Bureau of Mediation Services reveal that an exclusive representative has **not** been selected:

VOTES FOR NO REPRESENTATIVE	(26)
TOTAL VOTES TABULATED	(49)

Based on these election results, **IT IS CERTIFIED THAT AFSCME COUNCIL 65, NASHWAUK, Minnesota, is NOT** the exclusive representative for the employees falling within the appropriate unit of:

All Human Services and office support/clerical and technical employees of Des Moines Valley Health and Human Services, Windom and Jackson, Minnesota, who are public employees within the meaning of Minn. Stat. 179A.03, subd. 14, excluding public health nurses; health educators; health aides; and other non-clerical/technical public health employees and all supervisory and confidential employees.

The Maintenance of Status Quo Order issued by the Bureau on **March 9, 2015**, is hereby vacated.

The employer shall post this Order at the work locations of all employees involved.
