New Curricula Requirements — For All Schools —

Reminder! Recent rule changes require all schools to make changes to existing cosmetology and esthiology curricula.

Changes

Schools must remove topics and services now within the scope of esthetics (i.e. "electricity and light"), and incorporate eyelash extension training into cosmetology and esthiology training programs. Report your curriculum changes to the Board via a School Course or Curriculum Change Form, allowing at least 30 days for review.

Deadlines

Schools must teach the new curriculum to any students *starting* a cosmetology or esthiology training program on or after February 1, 2019.

Beginning June 1, 2019, schools must *not* teach cosmetology or esthiology students services identified in the scope of practice for AP esthetics, unless the student is enrolled in an AP esthetics training program.
