Approval of Draft Agenda

The December 4, 2019 draft agenda was reviewed and approved with the addition of Dr. Schwartz' request to discuss a refresher course for providers with allied sedation certifications.

Refresher Course for Allied Providers with Monitoring Certifications

Dr. Schwartz proposed a refresher course every five years for providers with allied sedation monitoring certifications. He recommends requiring a continuing education course with multiple anesthesia related topics including emergency protocols. The Committee will consider at a future meeting if a refresher course should be required in rule as part of the portfolio for required continuing education hours.

Unfinished Business

- a. Review of Moderate Sedation Inspection Forms

The Committee continued review of the *Moderate Sedation Inspection* forms and discussed elements as required by Rule and in consideration of best practices.

b. CSS Inspection Process Discussion

The Committee is proposing maintaining inspection every five years for Contracted Sedation Services providers that are licensed under the Dental Board.

The Committee is proposing a modified inspection every 5 years for the dentist that is contracting CSS services. The CSS provider would not have to be on site for this inspection, however, the dentist using their services would still undergo an inspection, with the inclusion of attestations on medications that are provided by their CSS provider. They would also be required to show that their facility meets criteria for providing sedation services, as required in rule. Medical emergency review will also be included in a modified sedation inspection process for this provider type.

MOTION: Dr. Rake made a motion to proceed with the proposed changes to the CSS inspection process.
