EXECUTIVE SESSION

Board Chair, T. Thompson called the executive session of the meeting to order at 9:06 a.m., in the Psychology Board Conference Room at 2829 University Avenue Southeast, Minneapolis, Minnesota, and a quorum was declared present.

1. In the Matter of Joseph T. Belanger, Ph.D., L.P., License No. LP4711

On recommendation from the Complaint Resolution Committee, the Board adopted the Stipulation and Consent Order which revokes Belanger's license to practice psychology.

PUBLIC SESSION

Board Chair, T. Thompson called the public session of the meeting to order at 9:25 a.m., in the Psychology Board Conference Room at 2829 University Avenue Southeast, Minneapolis, Minnesota, and a quorum was declared present.

1. Minutes of the Board Meeting of August 7, 2009.

a. HPSP Program Committee Meeting Report.

h. Per Diem Reimbursement for Preparation Time Study

Board members can be compensated for time spent preparing for meetings. The Board began a 3 month study on how much time Board members spend preparing for meetings. Board staff recommended that payment to Board members for preparation time be confined to a maximum of 2 days of preparation time and that it not begin until approximately July 1, 2010, the second year of the biennium. The data will be collected at the January 2010 Board meeting.
