

Operators + Salon Managers: What to Do Before You Renew

4-HOUR "CORE" COURSE + 4-HOUR "PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE" COURSE

COMPLETE 8 HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION

Starting August 1, 2017, two courses totaling 8 hours of pre-approved continuing education must be completed to renew a license as active. If you are unable to renew by July 31, 2017, you must have BOTH courses completed.



CORE: SAFETY, INFECTION CONTROL, LAWS + RULES

The 4-hour Core CE course has been required since 2014, so you may have already completed it for your last renewal. CE courses can't be "used" more than once—they must be completed before EVERY renewal.

STARTING AUG. 1: PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE

Starting August 1, 2017, all renewals must also certify completion of a 4-hour Professional Practice CE course. Professional Practice CE courses cover a wide variety of topics, from product chemistry to business management.
