New Business

a. Professional Development MN Rules Section 3100.5100

The Committee discussed and proposed revisions to MN Rules Section 3100.5100 to clarify language and remove obsolete sections. The process of exploring new language for Subpart 1A and B will include focus on the following:

- Delete the words “or more” when referring to Fundamental Activities.
- Subpart 1A in reference to the “cycle”.
- Delete the “CORE” subject section and retain only Elective and Fundamental categories.
- Self-assessment component

MOTION: Dr. Klampe made a motion to eliminate the self-assessment from Professional Development. Ms. Donnelly second. Motion unanimously approved.

Proposed revisions will go before the full Board for approval at the next board meeting before going through the legislative rulemaking process.

b. Professional Development MN Rules Section 3100.5100 Subp. 2 – CPR Requirement

The Committee discussed the COVID - 19 pandemic has caused many CPR courses to be cancelled. An emergency rule variance was discussed for licensees renewing between now and September 1, 2020 in the event hands-on courses are not offered in response to the social distancing recommendations by the Minnesota Department of Health.

MOTION: Dr. Klampe made a motion for an emergency 3100.1700 Subp. 2 CPR rule variance for licensees renewing between now and September 1, 2020 in the event hands-on courses are not offered in response to the social distancing recommendations by the Minnesota Department of Health. Ms. Donnelly second. Motion unanimously approved.

MOTION: Ms. Donnelly made a motion for an emergency rule variance to 3100.3600-Related ACLS Sedation Providers- Subp 2. A (3,4), Subp. 3 A (2,3), Subp.10 A (3) for licensees renewing between now and September 1, 2020 in the event that courses are

not offered in response to the social distancing recommendations by the Minnesota Department of Health. Ms. Donnelly second. Motion unanimously approved.


Ms. Anderson plans to review jurisprudence questions at a future meeting.
