

Documents accepted by the Board of Pharmacy to verify identity:

1. US state driver's license or state-issued ID card provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, sex, height, eye color, and address.
2. US Passport or US Passport Card.
3. ID card issued by federal, state, or local government agencies or entities, provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, sex, height, eye color, and address.
4. Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551).
5. Foreign passport that contains a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine-readable immigrant visa.
6. Employment Authorization Document that contains a photograph (Form I-766).
7. Foreign passport with Form I-94 or Form I-94A with Arrival-Departure Record, and containing an endorsement to work.
8. Voter's registration card.
9. US Military card or draft record.
10. Military dependent's ID card.
11. US Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card.
12. Native American tribal document.
13. Driver's license issued by a Canadian government authority.
14. Passport from the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) or the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) with Form I-94 or Form I-94A indicating nonimmigrant admission under the Compact of Free Association Between the United States and the FSM or RMI.
