**AMENDED
STIPULATION AND
CONSENT ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by Edwin P. Anderson, D.Min., L.P. (Licensee) and the Minnesota Board of Psychology (Board) as follows:

1. During all times herein, Licensee has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a license to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota.

FACTS

2. For the purpose of this stipulation, the Board may consider the following facts as true:

a. On May 1, 1998, the Board adopted and implemented the terms of a Stipulation and Consent Order, which Licensee agreed to and signed (May 1998 S&CO). A copy of that document is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

b. The May 1998 S&CO reprimanded Licensee and placed restrictions and conditions on his license. Licensee was permanently restricted to his current employment setting (as of May 1998), or a setting substantially similar, in that it is a group or team practice not involving psychotherapy to female patients. The May 1998 S&CO placed conditions on Licensee's license, including a requirement that Licensee complete twelve continuing education units each year for the next three years on the subjects of psychology practice ethics or professional boundaries.

c. On June 8, 1998, Licensee requested a time extension to complete the continuing education on ethics or professional boundaries required by paragraph 4.b.(2) of the May 1998 S&CO. Specifically, he asked that the time to complete the 12 continuing education units required within the first year of the May 1998 S&CO be extended until December 31, 1999.

d. On August 13, 1999, the Complaint Resolution Committee recommended that the full Board grant Licensee's request.

Based of the foregoing, the Board issues the following:

ORDER

3. Upon this stipulation and record and without any further notice or proceedings, the Board hereby **AMENDS** the May 1998 S&CO as follows: Paragraph 4.b.(2) is rescinded and now reads:

(2) **Continuing Education.** In each of the years 1999, 2000, and 2001, Licensee shall complete 12 continuing education units on the subjects of psychology practice ethics or professional boundaries. He must submit documentation of completing the 12 continuing education units required for 1999 no later than December 31, 1999; for 2000, no later than May 1, 2000; and for 2001, no later than May 1, 2001. Licensee may apply these units to his continuing education requirement for licensure renewal.

4. The remainder of the May 1998 S&CO remains in full force and effect.

5. This Amended Stipulation and Consent Order is a public document and will be sent to all appropriate data banks.
