#### **BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

April 26, 2019 – 10:30 a.m.

The mission of the Board of Behavioral Health and Therapy is to protect the public through effective licensure and enforcement of the statutes and rules governing its licensees to ensure a standard of competent and ethical practice.

#### Call to Order / Roll Call - Public Session 1.

Chair Marlae Cox-Kolek called the public session of the Board meeting to order at 10:55 a.m.

#### Approval of Board Meeting Minutes: January 25, 2019 2.

Judi Gordon moved to approve the January 25, 2019 Board Meeting Minutes. Roy Kammer seconded. All Board members present voted in favor of approving the Minutes.

#### 3. **Staff Member Reports**

#### Executive Director's Report (Kari Rechtzigel) A.

Budget Report (Receipts and Expenditures through March 31, 2019). Ms. Rechtzigel 1. reported that Board receipts through March 31, 2019 totaled \$1,041,214.52. The direct and indirect costs reflected on the report totaled \$615,604.98. The original biennial budget is \$642,000 (direct cost spending authority). Costs remain low, in part, because of unfilled staff positions pending classification decisions from Minnesota Management and Budget. The biennium ends on June 30, 2019. All unspent funds will transfer as non-dedicated funds in the State Government Special Revenue Fund.

- 2. Staff Presentations or Meetings (since last Board meeting). Ms. Rechtzigel provided Board members with the following list of staff member presentation and meeting activities.
  - a. February 6, 2019 Metropolitan State University (Strehlo)
  - b. February 12, 2019 St. Mary's University (Strehlo)
  - c. March 20, 2019 Department of Corrections Health Services Staff at BBHT (Rechtzigel, Strehlo). Staff met with Nanette Larson, Director of Health Services Department of Corrections (DOC) and Marina Fuhrman, MA, LPCC to discuss DOC

for the Minnesota Department of Corrections (DOC), and Marina Fuhrman, MA, LPCC to discuss DOC policies and BBHT requirements for interns, temporary permit and licensure applicants.

d. April 16, 2019 – Minneapolis Community and Technical College (MCTC) (Strehlo)

Judi Gordon reported that she and Ms. Rechtzigel met with Susan Sheridan Tucker, the new Executive Director of the Northstar Problem Gambling Alliance on February 26, 2019. When gambling was legalized in Minnesota, the legislature included funding for treatment. Ms. Tucker reported that training opportunities for providers are limited, and there is only one residential treatment program in Minnesota (The Vanguard Program in Granite Falls). Ms. Tucker also reported difficulty in obtaining information from the Department of Human Services related to training certification programs for problem gambling. Judi Gordon recommended that Ms. Tucker reach out to Senator Jim Abeler for assistance.

- 3. Staffing. Ms. Rechtzigel reported that on February 27, 2019, Minnesota Management and Budget denied BBHT's final appeal related to the job classification for the open LPC and LPCC programs administrator position. Ms. Rechtzigel conducted interviews for the LPC/LPCC Programs Administrator position on April 24, 2019. BBHT's open office manager position has been posted.
- 4. Board Member Appointments/Reappointments. Ms. Rechtzigel reported on the following vacancies and reappointment applicants:

Vacancies: LPC/LPCC Professional Member (Walter Roberts seat); Public Member (Freddie Davis-English seat)
Terms Expired 1.7.2019: Jacqueline Bluem, Marlae Cox-Kolek, Rebecca Lund,

Marjorie Van Slyke. All have applied for reappointment.

5. Board Chair Request for Diversity Training for Board Members and Staff

Chair Cox-Kolek invited discussion related to diversity training for Board members and staff members. Board members raised several issues related to diversity and equity including a shortage of persons of color in the counseling profession, disparities in management, and white supremacy. Board members are interested in having a speaker address the Board at a future meeting. Ongoing training could take place in a series of "brown bag" lunch training sessions open to the public. Judi Gordon moved to approve creating an Ad Hoc Committee on Diversity Training. Roy Kammer seconded. All Board members present voted in favor of the motion. The



following Board members were assigned to serve on the Ad Hoc Committee: Judi Gordon, Roy Kammer, Jacqueline Bluem, Rebecca Lund, and Carrie Lindberg.

6. 2019 State Regulatory Summit (State Licensure Board Meeting and AASCB) – Washington, DC – August 7-9, 2019

Ms. Rechtzigel informed Board members about the upcoming conference. Several Board members expressed interest in attending. Ms. Rechtzigel recommended having the new LPC/LPCC licensing administrator attend. Chair Cox-Kolek and Ms. Rechtzigel will review the Board's training and travel budget and determine how many Board and staff members can attend the conference.

- 7. Stephen Huot, Behavioral Health Services Director, Health Services Unit, Minnesota Department of Corrections is available to do a presentation to the Board or to the Board's Complaint Resolution Committees on mental health issues within the DOC. Board members for both complaint committees are interested in the presentation. CRC members and staff members are also interested in a tour of a correctional facility.
  - B. LADC Program Update (Samantha Strehlo)
- 1. Licenses Issued Since Last Board Meeting. Ms. Strehlo provided Board members with a list of persons licensed since the last quarterly Board meeting on January 25, 2019. Ms. Strehlo issued sixty-tow (62) LADC licenses and twenty-five (25) temporary permits since the last quarterly board meeting. *See* Attachment 1 to these Minutes.
- 2. Report on Program Operations. Ms. Strehlo reported that as the number of licensed professionals increases, complaints also increase. She thanked the members of the CRCs for their work and for being prepared for all monthly meetings. She noted the important perspective and contributions of public members.
  - C. LPC/LPCC Program Update (Kari Rechtzigel)
- 1. Licenses Issued Since Last Board Meeting. Ms. Rechtzigel provided Board members with a list of persons licensed since the last quarterly Board meeting on January 25, 2019. Ms. Rechtzigel issued seventy-one (71) LPCC licenses and thirty-six (38) LPC licenses since the last quarterly board meeting. See Attachment 1 to these Minutes.
- 2. Report on Program Operations. Ms. Rechtzigel reported no significant changes. Kristen Piper thanked Ms. Strehlo and Ms. Rechtzigel for their extra work during the months the LPC/LPCC program administrator position has been vacant.



### 4. Legislative Committee Report – Rechtzigel

A. BBHT Policy Bill for 2019: Senate File 955; House File 2206
(modifying reciprocity licensure; Duty to Warn provisions established for professional counselors, interns and supervisees; social work students and interns added). Ms. Rechtzigel testified at the following hearings: February 14, 2019 Senate Health and Human Services Finance and Policy Committee; March 6, 2019 – Senate Judiciary and Public Safety Finance and Policy Committee; March 20, 2019 – House Health and Human Services Policy Committee; and March 28, 2019 – House Civil Law Judiciary Finance and Civil Law Division Committee. She appreciated the hard work of Alan Ingram and others who represented Social Work's portion of the bill. Chief bill authors Senator Melissa Wiklund and Representative Tony Albright made sure the bill was heard in all necessary committees and met all committee hearing deadlines.

## 5. Termination of LPC, LPCC, and LADC Licenses for Nonrenewal

Judi Gordon moved to approve the termination of LPC and LPCC licenses on a list prepared by the Board staff. Amy Robinson seconded. All Board members present voted to approve the list of licenses to be terminated. *See* Attachment 2 to these Minutes.

#### 6. Public Comment Period

Anthony Maranca, a student visitor, stated he had a gambling addiction and went to the Vanguard Program in Granite Falls about four years ago. At that time, according to Mr. Maranca, Minnesota was one of three states with inpatient treatment for gamblers. He now believes seven or eight states have inpatient treatment programs.

### 7. Adjournment of Public Session

Kristen Piper moved to adjourn the meeting. Rebecca Lund seconded. The public session of the Board meeting adjourned at 12:10 p.m.
