1.2 **Repeal of Obsolete Rules Administered by the Board of Podiatric Medicine**

1.3 **6900.0010 DEFINITIONS.**

1.4 *[For text of subpart 1, see Minnesota Rules]*

1.5 Subp. 1a. **Acceptable graduate training.** "Acceptable graduate training" means at
1.6 least 12 consecutive months of postgraduate training in a clinical residency ~~or preceptorship~~
1.7 as described in part 6900.0020, subpart 5, ~~6, or 7.~~

1.9 **6900.0160 TEMPORARY PERMIT.**

1.10 Subpart 1. **Prerequisites.** An applicant for a temporary permit to practice podiatric
1.11 medicine must submit a complete, acceptable application for a Minnesota temporary permit
1.12 accompanied by the required fee. The clinical examination and personal interview may be
1.13 completed during the permit period.

1.14 The applicant must submit a transcript as provided in part 6900.0020, subpart 2, and
1.15 written evidence that the applicant has been accepted as a resident, ~~preceptee,~~ or graduate
1.16 trainee in an acceptable graduate training program.

1.19 **6900.0210 REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE.**

1.20 Subpart 1. **Requirements.** Upon a podiatrist's compliance with the requirements in
1.21 this part, the podiatrist's license must be reinstated. The podiatrist requesting reinstatement
1.22 of a license shall submit the following materials:

2.1 ~~C:~~ for each year the license has been inactive, evidence of participation in one-half
2.2 the number of hours of acceptable continuing education required for biennial renewal, under
2.3 part 6900.0300, up to five years;

2.4 ~~D:~~ if the license has been inactive for more than five years, the amount of
2.5 acceptable continuing education required in item C, must be obtained during the five years
2.6 immediately before application; or

2.7 ~~E:~~ C. other evidence as the board may reasonably require.

2.18 meetings may be used for license renewal each year); or

2.19 ~~C:~~ participation in acceptable graduate training.
