



BOARD MEETING MINUTES

January 28, 2022 – 10:00 a.m.

The mission of the Board of Behavioral Health and Therapy is to protect the public through effective licensure and enforcement of the statutes and rules governing its licensees to ensure a standard of competent and ethical practice.

1. Call to Order / Roll Call - Public Session

2. Sue Abderholden, Executive Director, National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) Minnesota

Sue has done public policy work since 1981. She explained NAMI's mission: "NAMI Minnesota champions justice, dignity, and respect for all people affected by mental illnesses. Through education, support, and advocacy we strive to effect positive changes in the mental health system and increase the public and professional understanding of mental illnesses." She summarized some of NAMI's legislative initiatives related to work force, supervision, loan forgiveness, training for family and peer specialists, grants to BIPOC providers, and changes to the Commitment Act. 4. Approval of November 19, 2021, Special Board Meeting Minutes

Kristen Piper moved to approve the November 19, 2021, Special Board Meeting Minutes. Amy Dols seconded. The following Board members voted in favor of approving the Minutes: Bluem, Crim, Dols, Harland, Kammer, Piper, Van Slyke. Cox-Kolek abstained. The Minutes were approved.

5. Staff Member Reports

- A. Executive Director's Report (Kari Rechtzigel). Rechtzigel reported on the Board's budget. She hopes to hire additional staff members if the budget allows.

- 5. Board Member and Staff Member Presentations and Meetings
- a. December 11, 2021 Roy Kammer appointed to Legislative Task Force on Human Services Background Study Eligibility; Dean Gilbertson resigned from the Task Force. Kammer reported that the Task Force established three subcommittees: Data, Disqualifications, and Remedies. Kammer was appointed to the Data subcommittee. The Data subcommittee has been meeting weekly to review data. The Task Force has been meeting every other week to review data, policies, and procedures to formulate recommendations. The Task Force is focusing on pulling together information for an interim report that is due on March 1, 2022. Chair Crim acknowledged Kammer's efforts on the important work of the Task Force.
 - b. December 3, 2021 MSU-Mankato presentation to students (LADC licensure) (Strehlo)
 - c. December 3, 2021 MARRCH Public Policy Meeting (Rechtzigel, Strehlo)
 - B. LPC/LPCC Program Update (Kristin Loomer)
- 1. Licenses Issued Since Last Board Meeting. Ms. Loomer provided Board members with a list of persons licensed since the last quarterly Board meeting on October 29, 2021. Ms. Loomer issued one hundred eighteen (118) LPCC licenses and thirty-four (34) LPC licenses since the last quarterly Board meeting. See Attachment 1 to these Minutes.
 - 2. Report on Program Operations

Loomer reported she issues approximately 50 licenses each month. She has asked for help from members of the Application and Licensure Committee related to education reviews. She has upcoming presentations at Bethel University and the University of St. Thomas.

C. LADC Program Update (Samantha Strehlo)

- 1. Licenses Issued Since Last Board Meeting. Ms. Strehlo provided Board members with a list of persons licensed since the last quarterly Board meeting on October 29, 2021. Ms. Strehlo issued seventy-two (72) LADC licenses and thirty (30) temporary permits since the last quarterly Board meeting. See Attachment 1 to these Minutes.
- 2. Report on Program Operations meetings with MARRCH representatives Former Student language drafted for Exceptions to Licensure in 148F.11. Strehlo reported that she and Rechtzigel met with MARRCH representatives to discuss legislation related to the alcohol and drug counselor work force. There is a gap between when an individual's student status ends and when they obtain a license or permit to practice. Rechtzigel drafted language to add a definition of "former student" in the exceptions to license requirement in Minnesota Statutes section 148F.11. Under the proposed language, a former student can practice under supervision for 90 days after their student status ends to allow them time to complete the licensure process. Chair Crim stated this proposal is extremely good news. It will lower employer and practitioner stress levels. The language is appropriate and will create an efficient way to continue quality care for clients.



Strehlo has noticed a rise in the number of individuals with temporary permits who reach the renewal limit. Permits can only be renewed five times. Renewals are annual renewals. If an individual does not meet the requirements for licensure when they can no longer practice under a temporary permit, they cannot practice alcohol and drug counseling. In 2017, three individuals were in this position. In 2021, nine individuals were in this position. So far in 2022, fourteen individuals are in the position of having their permit end and not being able to meet licensure requirements. Several permit holders practice in outstate Minnesota. From 2022 to 2023, there are twenty-one individuals with permits ending and not qualifying for full licensure.

Strehlo reminded Board members that BBHT proposed a legislative change to make the permit a permanent credential. The professional association, MARRCH, opposed the idea. Tiered licensure for alcohol and drug counselors was being studied at the time. Jackie Bluem asked the reason for the pushback on the proposal. Strehlo responded that the idea was to have a career ladder – associate degree, bachelor's degree, possible master's degree. Kammer clarified that the scope of practice is very broad at the bachelor's degree level. One problem with a tiered license is how to differentiate scope of practice and tasks if a master's level is created. Changing requirements would likely impact the work force for alcohol and drug counselors.

3. Number of Active Licenses. Ms. Strehlo reported the following information on the number of active licenses:

4. Database Project. Strehlo reported that the Board's new ALIMS database went live on November 17, 2021. There were some problems. After sending out an email blast to licensees and applicants, hundreds of people went to the website to register for online services. Staff members were overwhelmed with questions for a time. It was a learning process. Future projects include developing online license applications and online supervisor applications. These will be created using Odyssey Project funding. Chair Crim asked how many months it will be until online applications are available. Strehlo noted it is a good question. It will be several months. The immediate goal is to get used to online renewals and other functions first. Paper applications can be frustrating for applicants and staff members. Joesha Green noted it will be nice for applicants to be able to pay application fees online with a credit card and complete applications online.



6. Variance Requests

- A. Victoria Molko, MA, LPCC #2232. Molko requested a variance to Minnesota Rules part 2150.5010, subpart 4.D. related to the requirement that supervision must be completed in no fewer than 12 consecutive months and no more than 36 consecutive months. Specifically, Molko requested that the Board allow supervised practice hours completed between January 2019 and January 31, 2023, to be accepted for meeting licensure requirements related to supervision. Cox-Kolek moved to approve the request. Kammer seconded. Board members voting in favor of the request: Jacqueline Bluem, Marlae Cox-Kolek, Derrick Crim, Amy Dols, Corey Harland, Roy Kammer, Kristen Piper, Marjorie (DeDe) Van Slyke. None opposed. The variance request was **granted**.
- B. A.L., LPCC Applicant #136039. Applicant requested a variance to Minnesota Rules part 2150.5010, subpart 4.A. related to the requirement that professional counselors must obtain post-degree supervision by an approved supervisor. Applicant requested variances for three supervisors. Separate motions were considered for each supervisor.

Amy Dols moved to approve the request to accept supervised practice hours provided by Kelvin Mutter. Jackie Bluem seconded. Discussion followed that the supervised practice hours were pre-degree hours. A new motion was offered by Kristen Piper to deny the request. DeDe Van Slyke seconded. The Board voted unanimously to deny the variance request because the supervision occurred before Applicant's master's degree was awarded. Board members voting to deny the variance request: Jacqueline Bluem, Marlae Cox-Kolek, Derrick Crim, Amy Dols, Corey Harland, Roy Kammer, Kristen Piper, Marjorie (DeDe) Van Slyke.

Kristen Piper moved to approve the variance request to accept supervised practice hours provided by Daniel Brodie Smith. Marlae Cox-Kolek seconded. The Board voted unanimously to **approve** the variance request. The Board accepts 671 work hours, 400 direct client contact hours, and 30 individual supervision hours Applicant completed with Daniel Brodie Smith. Board members voting to grant the variance request: Jacqueline Bluem, Marlae Cox-Kolek, Derrick Crim, Amy Dols, Corey Harland, Roy Kammer, Kristen Piper, Marjorie (DeDe) Van Slyke.

Kristen Piper moved to deny the variance request to accept supervised practice hours provided by Elke Scholz. Roy Kammer seconded. Board members voting to deny the request: Marlae Cox-Kolek, Derrick Crim, Amy Dols, Corey Harland, Roy Kammer, Kristen Piper, Marjorie (DeDe) Van Slyke. Board member voting to grant the request: Jackie Bluem. The variance request was **denied** (7 in favor of denial, 1 in favor of approval). Board members noted there was insufficient evidence that Scholz had any specific training in clinical supervision.



The Board **denied** Applicant's variance request to the statutory requirement that LPCC (general method) applicants receive "[a]t least 75 percent" of their required supervised practice in person." Minn. Stat. § 148B.5301, subdivision 2(c). General Method Petitioners' variance requests do not meet the criteria of variance requests that the Board can grant. Minn. Stat. § 14.055, subd. 1 and 2(4) ("the agency may not grant a variance from a statute or court order").

C. Joseph Lee Malhoit III, MA, LPC #2622

Malhoit requested a variance to Minnesota Rules part 2150.5010, subpart 4.A. related to the requirement that professional counselors must obtain supervision by an approved supervisor. Malhoit asked the Board to accept supervised practice hours he completed beginning in September of 2001 before licensure was created and before supervision rules were adopted. Jackie Bluem moved to approve the variance request. DeDe Van Slyke seconded. Discussion followed. The Board members voted unanimously not to approve the request. On the vote to approve the request, all Board members voted "nay." Board members voting nay: Jacqueline Bluem, Marlae Cox-Kolek, Derrick Crim, Amy Dols, Corey Harland, Roy Kammer, Kristen Piper, Marjorie (DeDe) Van Slyke. The variance request was **denied**.

The Board denied the request to count supervised practice hours and supervision hours Malhoit may have completed when he provided counseling services in the Employee Assistance Program with the FBI between September 2001 and 2017. Specifically, the Board denied the request because it was not specific and incomplete regarding the number of hours for which he was requesting approval. In addition, no information was provided regarding the qualifications of his supervisors with respect to supervision frequency and training in clinical supervision.

More importantly, the Board had significant concerns about public protection policy and precedent. Public protection is not served when individuals do not receive supervision from approved supervisors as set forth in the supervision rules which have been in place since July 5, 2005.

7. Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee (met December 13, 2021)

Jackie Bluem reported that the Committee meets every other month. The Committee and staff members discussed the budget for training or research activities. Costs for training and research can be included in the next biennial budget process. The Committee is considering working with a consultant to acquire data to assess need and workforce shortage issues in the BIPOC community. Factors to consider: what is the perceived problem; what biases can be identified; what is the goal; consultant must review data through DEI lens. The Committee is interested in complaint data and examination data and the role of diversity in those processes.



8. Termination of Licenses for Nonrenewal

Marlae Cox-Kolek moved to approve the termination of LPC and LPCC licenses on a list prepared by the Board staff. Kristen Piper seconded. The following Board members voted to approve the list of licenses to be terminated: Jacqueline Bluem, Marlae Cox-Kolek, Derrick Crim, Amy Dols, Corey Harland, Roy Kammer, Kristen Piper, Marjorie (DeDe) Van Slyke. The list of termination of licenses for non-renewal was approved. *See* Attachment 2 to these Minutes.

9. Public Comment Period

Gillian Koch, MEd, LPCC, Minnesota Counseling Association (MnCA) President, stated MnCA has hired a lobbying firm to assist them with Counseling Compact legislation. MnCA hopes to secure bill authors in the next week or two. She hopes the BBHT will prepare a letter of support for the legislation if requested. Rechtzigel stated BBHT will provide a letter upon request.

10. Adjournment of Public Session

Kristen Piper moved to adjourn the public session of the Board meeting. Jackie Bluem seconded. The public session adjourned at 12:23 p.m.
