**ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Physical Therapy ("Board"), having convened on May 15, 2014, to review the petition of Spencer D. Blackie, P.T. ("Petitioner"), for an unconditional license as a physical therapist in the State of Minnesota, makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 15, 2005, the Board approved a Stipulation and Order ("2005 Order") conditioning Petitioner's license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota.
2. The 2005 Order required Petitioner to complete a number of conditions, including: (a) the completion of coursework administered by the Minnesota Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association ("MNAPTA") and (b) on-site reviews of Petitioner's practice.
3. The Board has determined that Petitioner has satisfied the terms of the 2005 Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Petitioner has complied with and fulfilled the 2005 Order and hereby issues the following:

ORDER

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all previous orders, including the 2005 Order, are **RESCINDED** and shall have no future force or effect.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Petitioner, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
