1. Call to Order / Roll Call – Public Session

The Public Session of the Board meeting was called to order at 10:36 a.m.

2. Approval of Board Meeting Minutes: January 29, 2016

Marlae Cox-Kolek moved to approve the January 29, 2016 Board meeting minutes. Amy Robinson seconded. All Board members present voted “aye,” there were no nays, and the Minutes were approved.

3. Staff Member Reports

A. Executive Director’s Report (Kari Rechtzigel)

1. Budget Report (Receipts and Expenditures through March 31, 2016)

Ms. Rechtzigel reported that Board receipts collected through the third quarter of the fiscal year totaled 86% of the budget; expenditures totaled approximately 73% of the budget. The Board has collected above the amount of projected receipts and has spent slightly under projected expenditures. Ms. Rechtzigel explained that indirect costs (not part of base budget) were over the estimated amounts for the Health Professional Services Program (HPSP) and for legal services fees to the Attorney General’s Office for the LADC program. Samantha Strehlo added that FY 16 is the first year of the current biennium, and any funds not spent by June 30, 2016 will carry over into the next fiscal year. The carryover amount (available balance) at the present time is approximately \$14,000.

Ms. Strehlo noted that the licensure numbers were fairly typical for a three-month period. She had no special information to report on program operations.

2. Report on Program Operations

Ms. LaBrocca noted that she issued more LPC licenses than LPCC licenses in the month of April.

4. Variance Requests

A. Erin Seiner, MA, LPCC Applicant (#127624)

Walter Roberts moved to approve Ms. Seiner's request for a variance to Minnesota Rules part 2150.5010, subpart 4.A. related to completing supervised practice hours with an approved supervisor. Marlae Cox-Kolek seconded. Board members voted unanimously to approve the request. Ms. Seiner may count supervised practice hours and supervision hours completed under the supervision of Julie Dokken, MS, LPCC (North Dakota) for purposes of meeting the supervision requirements for LPC/LPCC licensure in Minnesota.

B. Kristina Dwyer, MA, LPCC Applicant (#124693)

Walter Roberts moved to approve Ms. Dwyer's request for a variance to Minnesota Rules part 2150.5010, subpart 4.D., related to completing supervised practice hours for LPC/LPCC licensure in more than 72 consecutive months. Rebecca Lund seconded. Board members voted unanimously to approve the request. Ms. Dwyer may count all supervised practice hours completed under the supervision of Marie Logan and Kay Dorr for purposes of meeting the supervision requirements for LPC/LPCC licensure in Minnesota.

5. Legislative Committee Report on Meetings Conducted on February 11, March 2, and April 21, 2016 - Walter Roberts

Dr. Roberts informed Board members that a final version of bill language was jacketed to create a licensed associate alcohol and drug counselor (LAADC) license to replace the current temporary permit as well as language expanding reciprocity for all license types issued by the Board. He related that the Committee received opposition to the LAADC proposal from MARRCH and from alcohol and drug counselor educators. The Committee decided not to pursue LAADC licensure. The reciprocity initiative will be picked up again in the 2017 session. Dr. Roberts also noted that the Board should propose language in 2017 to add LPC and LPCC interns to the protective language related to "Duty to Warn" situations. A 2016 bill passed on this issue but it did not include LPC and LPCC interns (LADC interns are covered). He next reported that behavior analyst licensure is likely to resurface in 2017. There was no movement on the proposal in the 2016 session.

Dr. Roberts reported that Board staff members go to great lengths to inform interested parties about legislative initiatives and BBHT collaborates with them whenever possible. He dislikes the “whipsaw” effect on Board staff when professional association members bicker amongst themselves and can’t agree on what position to adopt. He noted that the Board staff is gracious under fire in these situations. The Board will work cooperatively with professional associations when they present a united front.

Dr. Roberts then introduced Tom Clawson, President and CEO of the National Board for Certified Counselors (NBCC). Dr. Clawson informed Board members that the NBCC was an important source of support in establishing LPC licensure in Minnesota. He provided information about his personal history related to counselor licensure. He was licensed in the State of Virginia in 1976. He researched counselor licensure while he was an intern at the College of William and Mary. He has experience as a school counselor and was also an instructor/professor for 15 years. He first joined the NBCC staff as Executive Director in 1989. He thanked the BBHT Board members for their service and for their role in public protection. He concluded with a message that the NBCC and CACREP plan to write a history of counselor licensure in the United States. Dr. Clawson left the meeting at 11:05 a.m.

After Dr. Clawson’s departure, discussion resumed about legislation. Board staff members and Legislative Committee members explained the history of the temporary permit to practice alcohol and drug counseling. They explained the reasons for not pursuing legislation in 2016 to change the current permit and licensure structure. Chair Gordon noted that the professional association, MARRCH, was not united in the position stated in their letter addressed to BBHT in response to the Tiered Licensure Working Group Report. Rebecca Lund opined that the reciprocity piece of BBHT’s legislative initiatives is important. It likely will provide clients access to more providers. Amy Robinson addressed the behavior analyst issue and noted that the current legislative draft needs more work, especially in the areas related to supervision and scope of practice.

6. Personnel Committee Report – Evaluation of Executive Director – Walter Roberts

Dr. Roberts provided Board members with a draft of an evaluation tool to evaluate the job performance of the Executive Director. He will gather all the data from the survey results and summarize it. He stated the goal is to provide feedback regarding what processes are going well and to identify any areas where efficiency of operations might be improved. In response to Chair Gordon’s question about when the survey will be available, Dr. Roberts responded that it should be ready within the next three months.

7. Policy and Rules Committee Report on Meetings Conducted on February 11 and March 10, 2016

The Committee is developing Bylaws for the BBHT, using a framework provided by the Board of Dentistry. The Committee is completing a section by section review and editing text as appropriate.

8. Health Professional Services Program (HPSP) Report – Yvonne Hundshamer

Ms. Hundshamer stated that reports that contain narrative information as opposed to just numbers are more useful. She explained that health-related licensing boards pay a \$2000 fee to HPSP to use their services. Boards then pay a fee for each licensee that participates in the program. She further reported that the HPSP does not plan to pursue any changes to its governance structure right now. Rather, a work group will continue to meet and study relevant issues. Ms. Hundshamer will serve on the work group. Ms. Hundshamer requested that Kari Rechtzigel send BBHT Board members a report she prepared that contains information about the Program Committee’s recent activities and information about a public member appointed to the HPSP Committee.

9. Termination of LPC/LPCC and LADC Licenses for Nonrenewal

Marlae Cox-Kolek moved to approve the termination of LPCC licenses on a list prepared by the Board staff. Amy Robinson seconded. All Board members present voted to approve the list of LPCC licenses to be terminated. See Attachment 2 to these Minutes for the licenses that were Board terminated.

10. Public Comment Period

Mark Anderson offered no comments. Lorraine Sellner stated she was present to learn about Board operations. She stated she appreciates the professionalism of the Board staff and Board members. Kimberly Carroll stated she likes the reciprocity initiative the Board plans to pursue at the Legislature. She reported frustration with the timeliness of communications with Board staff members. She believes more back-up should be provided when primary staff members are not available to answer questions. She expressed interest in serving as a Board member in the future.

11. Adjournment of Public Session

Rebecca Lund moved to adjourn the meeting. Bob Schmillen seconded. All Board members present voted in favor of adjourning the meeting and the public portion of the Board meeting adjourned at 11:48 a.m.
