**ORDER OF  
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Physical Therapy ("Board"), having convened on January 9, 2014, to review the petition of Teresa A. Burmis, P.T.A. ("Petitioner"), for an unconditional license as a physical therapist assistant in the State of Minnesota, makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On May 16, 2013, the Board approved a Stipulation and Order ("2013 Order") conditioning Petitioner's license to practice as a physical therapist assistant in the State of Minnesota.
2. The 2013 Order required Petitioner to successfully complete the Minnesota Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association Billing and Coding Course within nine months.
3. The Board has reviewed and considered Petitioner's petition and determined that Petitioner has satisfied the terms of the 2013 Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

**ORDER**

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all previous orders, including 2013 Order, are **RESCINDED** and have no future force or effect.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice as a physical therapist assistant in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Petitioner, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
