The Minnesota Comprehensive Health Association is regulated by the Minnesota Department of Commerce, and is guided by a board of directors. HF5/SF720 became law on April 4, 2017 and the legislation now requires that the board be made up of thirteen members, two of which must be selected by the Commissioner of Human Services. One of the positions must represent hospitals and one of the positions must represent health care providers. Applications for these two board positions are being accepted until 5 pm on Tuesday, June 6, 2017.
