- a. Dr. Estephan Moana is a Brazilian dentist. He has submitted a request to consider his training and allow him to advertise as an orofacial pain specialist. Dr. Estephan's a graduate of the Oral Facial Pain Residency and is seeking a Specialty Licensure. Dr. Moana is requesting a Variance for advertising once his Specialty License is granted.

MOTION: Dr. Ismail made a motion to approve the request upon Dr. Moana receiving Specialty Licensure before being granted the variance for advertising.

- b. Development of written exam for Dental Therapy – Alex Vandiver (CDCA) and Stuart Blumenthal (CDCA) updated that they are in the process of developing a 100-question exam. Ms. Anderson indicated that the dental therapy exam will cover topics related to entry level scope of practice. Mr. Blumenthal and Ms. Fogarty will assemble a team to review what currently exists in the dental OSCE exam that could be relevant to DT practice. They will also develop new questions. The final written test is scheduled to be completed by January 20, 2020 as expected. Dr. Self stressed that accrediting agencies track and penalize schools if there are too many students failing exams. During this session, Dr. Self suggested that the Board provides feedback to educational programs during a reasonable time frame so that schools can prepare students to meet the requirements of the examination.
