Instructions. You may use this form to file a complaint against a Pharmacist, pharmacy technician or intern, pharmacy, or a drug manufacturer, wholesaler or distributor. The information you provide will be evaluated to determine whether the Board will take action. Failing to provide with your identity may prohibit the Board from investigating alleged violations adequately, and we will not be able to provide you with status updates. Per Minnesota statutes, we keep the identity of complainants confidential, although it is sometimes possible to guess the identify of the complainant due to the nature of the complaint.
