4. Data Element Review and Selection for EMSRB NEMESIS version 3.4.0 Data Dictionary

Mr. Norlen explained two documents (NEMESIS version 3 Worksheet and Other State Selected version 3 Elements) the committee would be working from to review NEMESIS version 3.4.0 dataset elements. Mr. Norlen indicated the committee would start with the “e” elements in the dataset and the demographic elements would be reviewed at future meetings. Discussion took place on process for review of elements for making recommendations on elements to include in the Minnesota data dictionary. The consensus of the committee was to review each element individually. Elements would receive a “Yes” or “No” based on committee consensus following discussion.

The committee started with “eResponse.01” and completed through “eScene.14”. The recommendations made by the committee are reflected in the NEMESIS version 3 Worksheet – column “2015 DPSAC Review”. The committee will begin with “eScene.15” at the scheduled September 14, 2015 meeting.
