

Minnesota Board of Chiropractic Examiners Doctor of Chiropractic Application for Emeritus Status

Tennessee Warning

You are being asked to supply private or confidential data as part of an application for issuing or renewing a license or registration. The purpose and intended use of this information is to enable the Board to determine whether you meet statutory and rule requirements for license or registration issuance or renewal. You are not required to provide this information. However, failure to do so may impede your ability to receive or renew a license or registration. This data is classified as confidential during the pendency of the application but may then, with the exception of Social Security Numbers, become public following issuance or renewal of the license or registration. Board staff, Board designees, and staff of the Attorney General's office may have access to this data, as required for review of this application. Questions and answers regarding previous licensure or conduct are maintained as confidential and will become private once the license or registration is issued or renewed. You have the right to consult with legal counsel before providing any information to the Board.

Information About This Application

MINN. R. 2500.2115 EMERITUS REGISTRATION APPLICATION.

Any doctor of chiropractic licensed to practice in the state pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, sections 148.01 to 148.105, who declares to be retired in all jurisdictions from the active practice of chiropractic may apply to the Board for Doctor of Chiropractic Emeritus registration. The chiropractor may do so by petitioning the Board if the chiropractor is completely retired and has not been the subject of disciplinary action resulting in the suspension, revocation, qualification, condition, or restriction of the chiropractor's license to practice chiropractic. There is no charge for the application, certificate, or modification of the license designation to emeritus status.

MINN. R. 2500.2120 STATUS OF EMERITUS REGISTRANT.

The emeritus registration is not a license to engage in the practice of chiropractic as defined in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 148, or in the rules of the board and the registrant shall not engage in the practice of chiropractic.

MINN. R. 2500.2125 EMERITUS CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS.

The continuing education requirements of parts 2500.1200 to 2500.2000 are not applicable to emeritus registration.

MINN. R. 2500.2130 EMERITUS CHANGE TO ACTIVE STATUS.

Subpart 3. Reinstatement. Reinstatement of an emeritus status to an active license status shall be done according to the reinstatement provisions of a voluntarily retired license in MINN R. 2500.2110.

MINN. R. 2500.2135 EMERITUS RENEWAL CYCLE FEES.

Being registered as emeritus will not subject a person to the annual renewal cycle fees.

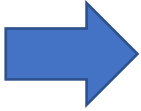

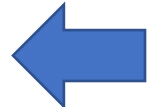

- At such time as I may decide to return my DC Emeritus license to an Active status, I understand that any continuing education units (CEUs) required for reinstatement of my license shall be separate from and in addition to the CEUs required for renewal at the end of the year.
- Further, I understand that once my license has been in DC Emeritus status for more than five years, my license may only be returned to active status following examination.
