

## **English Language Learner (ELL) Request**

The Minnesota Board of Psychology may authorize additional testing time when taking the Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology (EPPP). To apply for additional time for testing based on English Language Learner status, please complete one or more of the following:

1.	Applicant's attestation to the need for additional time to sit for the exam as they have limited
	proficiency in the English language and/or they are an English Language Learner. Applicant shall
	submit a statement in writing to the Board in support of ELL request.

- Documentation of a Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) certification score of 85 or below; primary sourced document sent from the testing service directly to the Board would be accepted. Test would need to be within the last five years.
- 3. Documentation that applicant's doctoral degree was obtained from an educational institution outside the United States, and that coursework was presented primarily in a language other than English. An example of documentation could be a NACES evaluation; primary sourced document sent from the NACES credential evaluation member directly to the Board would be accepted. Enrollment in the educational institution must have occurred within the previous five years to the application with the Board of Psychology.

**Applicant Attestation**: I declare that the information provided on this form and in support of my English Language Learner request is true. I understand false information may be cause for denial of my application, cancellation of my EPPP examination score, or denial or loss of my license.
