

Eyelash Technicians: Salon Licensing

ALL EYELASH EXTENSIONS MUST BE OFFERED BY LICENSED INDIVIDUALS INSIDE OF LICENSED SALONS

ENSURE EVERYBODY IS LICENSED

Every person offering eyelash extensions within your business must have their own Eyelash Technician Operator License or Eyelash Technician Salon Manager License*. The period of time for obtaining these licenses through a grandfathering process has ended. Visit our homepage (mn.gov/boards/cosmetology) to find a list of course providers for obtaining an Eyelash Technician Operator License through completing the 38-hour course.



FIND THE RIGHT SPACE

When searching for a salon space, be aware of the physical requirements the salon must meet. For example, every service room must be equipped with a permanently plumbed-in hand-washing sink. A restroom sink will not suffice. With older spaces or historic buildings, be mindful of any limitations that may prevent you from meeting the Board's requirements.

APPLY FOR YOUR SALON LICENSE

Check out the [Salon License Application](#) early. Become familiar with all physical, insurance, and business documentation requirements. Have a licensed salon manager in mind to sign on as your Designated Licensed Salon Manager. Complete and submit this application by mail or in-person. It will be reviewed within 15 business days of receipt (unless you choose to expedite). Await opening your salon until the salon license has been issued.
