**ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine (“Board”), having convened on February 5, 2014, to review the petition of Ann M. Fischer, D.V.M. (“Respondent”), for reinstatement of an unconditional license to perform veterinary medicine in Minnesota, makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. By Stipulation and Order dated September 11, 2013, the Board stayed the suspension of Respondent's license for a period of time. The Stipulation and Order was based on behavior the Board deemed as a departure from the minimum standards of acceptable and prevailing practice and unprofessional conduct.
2. Respondent submitted evidence of successful completion of preapproved continuing education.
3. Respondent submitted evidence of demonstrating proficiency in companion animal dental extraction and surgical flaps.
4. Respondent successfully completed required continuing education courses.

Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Respondent has complied with and fulfilled the terms and conditions of the Stipulation and Order issued by the Board on September 11, 2013, and hereby issues the following order:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stayed suspension status of Respondent's veterinary license be removed and an unconditional veterinary license be conferred upon Respondent, such certificate to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
