ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE

The Complaint Resolution Committee (Committee) of the Minnesota Board of Psychology (Board) convened on January 8, 2016, to review the matter of Nicholas C. Gammello, M.A., LP (Licensee) to consider the removal of the conditions placed on his license by a Stipulation and Consent Order, adopted and implemented by the Board on January 24, 2014 (January 2014 Order). The Committee determines that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled all conditions set forth in the January 2014 Order as follows:

1. Pursuant to paragraph 5., Licensee completed an individualized professional boundaries course.
2. Pursuant to paragraph 5.A., Licensee submitted a report on the individualized professional boundaries course.
3. Pursuant to paragraph 5.B., Licensee caused to be submitted a report on the individualized professional boundaries course from the instructor of the course.

The Committee has verified Licensee's compliance with the remedy listed in paragraph 5, and all subsequent paragraphs of the January 2014 Order. Pursuant to the January 2014 Order, having determined satisfactory completion of the remedy requirements, the Committee shall administratively reinstate Licensee's license.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

ORDER

Licensee shall be granted an **UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE** to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.

The January 2014 Order is superseded by this Order of Unconditional License and shall have no future force or effect.
