**ORDER OF  
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Physical Therapy (“Board”), having convened on November 13, 2014, to review the petition of Paul Holmquist, P.T. (“Petitioner”), for an unconditional license as a physical therapist in the State of Minnesota, makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On November 18, 2010, the Board approved a Stipulation and Order (“2010 Order”) issuing Petitioner a reprimand in addition to conditioning and restricting his license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota.

2. The 2010 Order required Petitioner to complete a number of conditions, including: (a) the completion of coursework and (b) on-site and off-site reviews of Petitioner’s practice conducted by the Minnesota Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association (“MNAPTA”).

3. The Board has determined that Petitioner has satisfied the terms of the 2010 Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Petitioner has complied with and fulfilled the 2010 Order and hereby issues the following:

**ORDER**

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all previous orders, including the 2010 Order, are **RESCINDED** and will have no future force or effect.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Petitioner, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
