ORDER OF UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE

The Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine ("Board"), having convened to review the petition of Richard V. Huston, D.V.M. ("Licensee"), for reinstatement of an unconditional license to practice veterinary medicine, makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 28, 2010, the Board issued a Stipulation and Order for Conditional License ("Order") in this matter.
2. On August 8, 2011, the Board received Licensee's petition for unconditional license in accordance with part V of the Order.
3. Information submitted in connection with Licensee's petition and obtained by the Board in the course of monitoring Licensee's compliance with the Order shows that Licensee has fulfilled all requirements of the Order and has met the conditions for reinstatement of an unconditional license.

Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled the Order and hereby issues the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Licensee is granted an unconditional license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota effective September 27, 2011, such license to carry

all duties, benefits, responsibilities and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statutes and rules.
