To persons who requested a hearing. In accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 14.25, subdivision 1, the Department is sending this Notice to all persons who requested a hearing.

There will be a hearing. In the May 12, 2014, State Register, on pages 1477 to 1480, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners published a Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules relating to Independent Examiner Registrations. The Notice stated that the Board would hold a hearing on the proposed rules if 25 or more persons submitted written requests. We have received a sufficient number of requests for a hearing. The hearing will be conducted as stated in the State Register in Conference Room A of University Park Plaza located at 2829 University Avenue Southeast in Minneapolis, starting at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, July 8, 2014.
