INSTRUCTORS & SCHOOL MANAGERS: When is it OK to **DOUBLE-DIP** continuing education?

There are certain special conditions under which instructors and school managers may use the same CE course to renew their specialty license AND their underlying practitioner license (operator, salon manager).

Instructors teaching approved Core and Professional Practice CEs may apply the CE hours from the courses on the instructor's operator or salon manager license renewal if the CE hours are claimed only once per course, and are not used again on future renewals.

A school manager may apply the CE hours from an approved Professional Practice CE course on business management to the renewal of both the underlying salon manager license and the school manager license.

When a course has been approved by the Board as both a Professional Practice CE course and as an Instructor Clinical Practice CE course, instructors may apply the CEs earned from the course to the renewal of both the instructor license and the practitioner license.
