**ORDER OF  
UNCONDITIONAL CERTIFICATE**

The Minnesota Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board (“Board”), having convened on January 16, 2014, to review the petition of Kelsey J. Jacobson, Paramedic (“Respondent”), for reinstatement of an unconditional certificate to perform paramedic services in Minnesota, makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. By Final Order dated November 20, 2012, the Board suspended the certificate of Respondent for a period of time. The Final Order was based on behavior the Board deemed as actually or potentially unable to provide emergency medical services with reasonable skill and safety by reason of illness, use of alcohol, drugs, chemicals, or any other material, or as a result of any mental or physical condition.
2. Respondent submitted reports from two adult persons, at least one of whom is not related to Respondent, attesting to Respondent’s sobriety.
3. Respondent submitted evidence of active participation in a chemical dependency rehabilitation program.
4. Respondent submitted a report from her employment supervisor.
5. Respondent submitted evidence of treatment and weekly participation in a chemical dependency support group during the 12 months preceding the petition.

6. Respondent submitted evidence of maintaining the knowledge, skills, and ability, to work as a paramedic safely.

7. Respondent submitted a report from her physician.

8. Respondent submitted a report from her mental health treatment professional.

Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Respondent has complied with and fulfilled the terms and conditions of the Final Order issued by the Board on November 20, 2012, and hereby issues the following order:

**ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the suspended status of Respondent's Paramedic certificate be removed and an unconditional Paramedic certificate be conferred upon Respondent, such certificate to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
