**ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

1. The Minnesota Board of Dentistry ("Board") is authorized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes chapter 150A to regulate persons who are licensed to practice dentistry in the State of Minnesota, and further is authorized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes sections 214.10 and 214.103 to review complaints against licensed dentists and to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Michael Gene Johnson, D.D.S. ("Licensee") is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a license to practice dentistry in the State of Minnesota.

3. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 214.101, subdivisions 1 and 4, the license of a dentist must be suspended if the licensee is found by a court, administrative law judge or public authority to be in arrears in child support or maintenance payments or both.

4. On August 21, 2013, the Board received notification from the Hennepin County Child Support that Licensee is in arrears in court-ordered child support and under Minnesota Statutes sections 214.101 and 518A.66 the Board must suspend Licensee's license to practice dentistry in the State of Minnesota.

5. On June 14, 2013, the Board adopted a Stipulation and Order for Limited and Conditional License ("2013 Order") that placed a limitation and conditions on Licensee's dental license.

6. The authority to sign orders suspending licenses pursuant to Minnesota Statutes sections 214.101 and 518A.66 has been delegated to the Executive Director of the Board.

**ORDER**

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Licensee's license to practice dentistry in the State of Minnesota shall be **SUSPENDED**, effective immediately. During the period of suspension, Licensee shall not engage in the practice of dentistry, as defined by Minnesota Statutes section 150A.05 in the State of Minnesota.


2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Licensee is in possession of his current license renewal certificate, Licensee shall surrender and personally deliver or mail the certificate to Marshall Shragg, Executive Director, Minnesota Board of Dentistry, 2829 University Avenue Southeast, Suite 450, Minneapolis, Minnesota 55414, within ten days of the date of this Order.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the suspension shall remain in effect until such time as the Board receives notification from the court, administrative law judge, or public authority that referred this matter to the Board confirming that Licensee is not in arrears in either child support or maintenance payments, or confirming that Licensee is in compliance with a written payment plan regarding both current support and arrearages.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the 2013 Order is placed in abeyance. The requirements of the 2013 Order shall be reinstated after completion of this Order.
