**ORDER OF
REINSTATEMENT
OF LICENSE**

1. The Minnesota Board of Dentistry (“Board”) is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 150A (2012) to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, petition, or hold licenses to practice dentistry in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 214.10 and 214.103 (2012) to review complaints against dentists, to refer such complaints to the Attorney General’s Office, and to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Michael Gene Johnson, D.D.S. (“Licensee”) has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a license to practice dentistry in the State of Minnesota.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 214.101, subds. 1 and 4 (2012), the license of a dentist must be suspended if the licensee is found by a court, administrative law judge, or public authority to be in arrears in court-ordered child support or maintenance payments, or both.

4. On August 21, 2013 the Board received a Notice to Suspend Occupational or Professional License(s) from Hennepin County Child Support, Minneapolis, Minnesota, which advised the Board that Licensee was not in compliance with a court order for child support, and under Minn. Stat. §§ 214.101 and/or 518A.66 (2012), the Board must suspend Licensee’s license to practice dentistry in the State of Minnesota.

5. On August 27, 2013, the Board issued an Order for Suspension and served it on Licensee, as required by Minn. Stat. § 518A.66 (2012).

6. On September 27, 2013, the Board adopted a Stipulation and Order for Stayed Suspension, Limited, and Conditional License (“September 27, 2013 Order”).

7. On November 7, 2013, the Board received notification from Hennepin County Child Support, that Licensee was in compliance with a court order or payment agreement for child support and/or maintenance payments, and that Licensee was entitled to reinstatement of his dental license.

8. The authority to sign orders reinstating professional licenses pursuant to notification by a court, administrative law judge, or public authority regarding child support or maintenance payments, or both, has been delegated by the Board to its Executive Director.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Order of Suspension issued by the Board, effective August 27, 2013, is RESCINDED and Licensee’s dental license is REINSTATED effective November 20, 2013.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the September 27, 2013 Order remains in force and is not affected by this Order.
