ORDER OF  
UNCONDITIONAL  
LICENSE

The Minnesota Board of Psychology (Board) convened on January 24, 2014, to review the petition of Dick Jones, PhD, LP (Licensee) for removal of the conditions placed on his license by a Stipulation and Consent Order, adopted and implemented by the Board on October 18, 2012 (October 2012 Order). Having considered the Complaint Resolution Committee's (Committee) recommendation that Licensee be granted an unconditional license, the Board determines that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled all conditions set forth in the October 2012 Order as follows:

1. Pursuant to paragraph 4.a., within one (1) month of the date the October 18 Order is adopted by the Board, Licensee must obtain a supervising psychologist and meet with the supervising psychologist no less than one (1) hour per twenty (20) hours of Licensee's practice. Licensee shall practice only under the supervision of a supervising psychologist approved in advance by the Committee.
2. Pursuant to paragraph 4.b., the scope of Licensee's supervision shall include, but is not limited to, case review, psychological test interpretation, psychological report writing, and addressing client confidentiality, privacy, and other related ethical concerns.
3. Pursuant to paragraph 4.c., the supervising psychologist shall provide a report to the Committee every three (3) months and at the time Licensee petitions to have the supervision condition removed from his license.

The Committee received documentation verifying Licensee's compliance with the remedy listed in paragraphs 4.a. through 4.c. and all subsequent paragraphs of the October 2012 Order.


Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

**ORDER**

Licensee shall be granted an UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
