**ORDER FOR
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Dentistry ("Board") met to review the petition of Peter M. Jorgenson, D.D.S. ("Licensee") for reinstatement of an unconditional license to practice dentistry in Minnesota.

BACKGROUND

1. Licensee and the Board's Complaint Committee ("Committee") entered into a Stipulation and Order which was approved by the Board on December 14, 2001, ("2001 Stipulation and Order") that reinstated Licensee's license to practice dentistry and also placed conditions on Licensee's dental license. The 2001 Stipulation and Order was based on evidence that dealt with Licensee's chemical dependency and non-compliance with his previous Stipulation and Order issued by the Board in 1995.

2. Pursuant to paragraph D. of the 2001 Stipulation and Order, Licensee's license was placed in a conditional status.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board makes the following findings of fact:

3. Pursuant to paragraph D. of the 2001 Stipulation and Order, Licensee was required to do the following:

a. Paragraph D.1. required Licensee to contact the Health Professionals Services Program ("HPSP") to schedule a chemical dependency evaluation. Licensee signed a Participation Agreement/Monitoring Plan with HPSP in a timely manner.

b. Paragraph D.2. required Licensee to cause the evaluator to provide a report of the evaluation and subsequent treatment recommendations to the Committee and required that Licensee comply with the evaluator's recommendations. Licensee provided a copy of the evaluation report including treatment recommendations to the Committee and HPSP whereby the recommendations were incorporated into Licensee's Monitoring Plan with HPSP.

c. Paragraph D.3. required Licensee to comply with the terms of any treatment recommendations made by HPSP which are hereby incorporated by reference. Licensee successfully completed his Participation Agreement/Monitoring Plan and was discharged from HPSP.

d. Paragraph D.4. required Licensee to sign all necessary releases allowing Board access to all medical, chemical dependency, and/or mental health records. Licensee complied with this requirement.

e. Paragraph D.5. required Licensee to pay license renewal and late fees as determined by the Board. Licensee paid the fees and his license was reinstated by the Board.

f. Paragraph D.6. required Licensee to comply with all laws and rules of the Board of Dentistry, cooperate with the Board's requests, and comply with the most current infection control requirements. The Committee has not received any indication that Licensee has violated this portion of the 2001 Stipulation and Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Licensee has complied with his 2001 Stipulation and Order issued by the Board on December 14, 2001 and hereby issues the following:

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that an UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE to practice dentistry in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Licensee, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
