## **MINUTES OF SPECIAL BOARD MEETING, July 18, 2007**

The Board of Veterinary Medicine held a special meeting on July 18, 2007, in Conference Room C, Third Floor, University Park Plaza, 2829 University Avenue Southeast, Minneapolis, Minnesota. Vice President John Lawrence called the meeting to order at 2:33 p.m.

In the matter of William N. Dudley, DVM, License Number C0858, Ms. Gronvall presented oral argument on behalf of the Complaint Committee; and Mr. Kuderer argued on behalf of Dr. Dudley. Dr. Dudley also spoke on his own behalf.

The meeting was closed. Ms. Lundstrom was the board's advising attorney. Following deliberation, Dr. Glattly moved and Mr. Geske seconded to adopt the Complaint Committee's proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Decision and Order with agreed upon modifications to the Administrative Law Judge's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. Motion passed unanimously (revocation of license and administrative penalty).

Tiernee Murphy has replaced Sebastian Stewart as the Assistant Attorney General handling the equine dentistry lawsuit. Ms. Murphy updated the board on the status of the case.

An Amended Stipulation and Order signed by Dr. Susan Molloy was discussed. Dr. Murphy moved and Mr. Geske seconded to accept the order as written. Passed unanimously.

A Stipulation and Order signed by Dr. Edward Foeltz mirroring an order issued by the North Dakota board was discussed. Dr. Glattly moved and Dr. Lawrence seconded to accept the order as written. Passed unanimously.

The meeting re-opened and adjourned at 4:50.
