ORDER OF UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE

The Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine ("Board"), having convened on May 14, 2014, to review the petition of Stephen A. Lavallee, D.V.M. ("Petitioner"), for an unconditional license as a veterinarian in the State of Minnesota, makes the following:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- On September 27, 2013, the Board approved a Stipulation and Order ("2013
  Order") conditioning Petitioner's license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota.
- 2. The 2013 Order required Petitioner to pay a \$1,000 administrative penalty and successfully complete at least 18 hours of interactive veterinary continuing education to make up for continuing education hours Petitioner failed to completed for the March 1, 2011 to February 28, 2013 licensure renewal period.
- 3. The Board has reviewed and considered Petitioner's petition and determined that Petitioner has satisfied the terms of the 2013 Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

## **ORDER**

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all previous orders, including 2013 Order, are **RESCINDED** and have no future force or effect.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Petitioner, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
