**ORDER OF  
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine (“Board”), having convened on December 14, 2022, to review the reinstatement of Amanda Maijer, D.V.M. (“Petitioner”), of an unconditional license as a veterinarian in the State of Minnesota, makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On December 14, 2022, the Board approved a Stipulation and Order (“2022 Order”) conditioning Petitioner’s license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota.
2. The 2022 Order required Petitioner to comply with and satisfy all requirements set forth in the 2022 Order. The 2022 Order further required Petitioner to provide the Board with evidence that she satisfied the 2022 Order.
3. The Board has reviewed the requirements set forth in the 2022 Order and determined that Petitioner has satisfied the terms of the 2022 Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

**ORDER**

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the 2022 Order is **RESCINDED** and has no future force or effect.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Petitioner, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
