Ms. Huntley thanked Kita Nelson, Paul Luecke, Mark Chu, Tiernee Murphy and the partners from Lynmark, the data management system team, for their collaborative work on the effort.

### *Legislative Updates:*

Ms. Huntley noted there was a presentation at the Policy & Planning Committee meeting by the Minnesota Society of Anesthesiologists regarding a new license type that they are pursuing and looking to be regulated by the Board of Medical Practice. Ms. Huntley is working with Legislative Liaison, Lindsey Franklin, to schedule meetings with some key legislators in advance of session beginning next month.

Ms. Huntley is continuing to work with the revisors' office to clean up some language regarding birth month renewals for most of the allied professionals under the Board's regulation.

### *Partnerships:*

Ms. Huntley and Dr. Anand will be attending a one-day training course sponsored by the FSMB on Trauma Informed Regulation.

The Administrators of Medicine (AIM) and Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission (IMLCC) both had their annual meetings in November. Ms. Huntley recognized Mr. Manahan's leadership as Chair of the Commission during the 2025 calendar year.

Finally, Ms. Huntley noted the PA Compact is making great progress toward operationalization.

*Outreach/Development:*

Dr. Sutor, Kim Navarre, HPSP Program Director, and Ms. Huntley are scheduled to present to the 4<sup>th</sup> year medical students at Mayo in February.

- Workforce is growing and diversifying, but **retention and burnout** are critical challenges.

- Satisfaction trends show systemic issues post-COVID, requiring policy focus on **workforce resilience** and retention strategies.

**FINDINGS OF FACT,  
CONCLUSIONS, AND  
FINAL ORDER**

The Minnesota Board of Medical Practice (“Board”) Complaint Review Committee (“Committee”) initiated a contested case proceeding in this matter pursuant to a Notice and Order for Prehearing Conference and Hearing (“Notice of Hearing”), served and filed on October 9, 2025, to determine whether discipline should be imposed against the physician assistant’s license of Charles K. Sangmoah, P.A. (“Respondent”). This matter was scheduled for a prehearing conference at the Minnesota Court of Administrative Hearings on November 6, 2025, before Administrative Law Judge Christa L. Moseng (“ALJ”). Carlos Figari, Assistant Attorney General, appeared at the prehearing conference on behalf of the Committee. There was no appearance at the prehearing conference by, or on behalf of, Respondent.

On December 4, 2025, the ALJ issued a Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation upon Default (“ALJ’s Report”), recommending that the Board take disciplinary action against Respondent’s license. (A true and accurate copy of the ALJ’s Report is attached and incorporated as Exhibit A.)

The Board convened to consider the matter at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board on January 10, 2026. The Board’s business address is 335 Randolph Avenue, Suite 140, St. Paul, Minnesota 55102. The following Board members were present: Chaitanya Anand, M.B., B.S.; Bruce Anderson; Sarah Carter, M.D.; Pamela Gigi Chawla, M.D., M.H.A.; Tenbit Emiru, M.D.,

Ph.D., M.B.A.; Peter Henry, M.D.; Julie Pazdernik, M.D.; Allen Rasmussen, M.A.; Bruce Sutor, M.D.; Karen Thullner, M.F.A.; Jane Willett, D.O.; Leopold Arko IV, M.D.; Averi Turner.

Carlos Figari, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Board's Complaint Review Committee. Respondent did not appear before the Board. Michael McSherry and Hans Anderson, Assistant Attorneys General, were present as legal advisors to the Board.

The following Board members did not participate in deliberations: Peter J. Henry, M.D.; Bruce Sutor, M.D.; and Karen Thullner, M.F.A. Board staff who assisted the Committee did not participate in the deliberations.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

The Board has reviewed the record of this proceeding and accepts the December 4, 2025, ALJ's Report and adopts and incorporates by reference the ALJ's Report as Findings of Fact herein. Paragraphs 4 and 5 of the Conclusions of Law in the ALJ's Report state:

4. Under Minn. R. 1400.6000, the Respondent is in default as a result of his failure to appear at the scheduled prehearing conference.
5. Under Minn. R. 1400.6000, when a party defaults by failing to appear at a prehearing conference without the prior consent of the judge, the allegations and the issues set out in the Notice and Order for Prehearing Conference and Hearing may be taken as true and deemed proven. The Judge deems the allegations to be true.

The Notice of Hearing states as follows:

1. On September 16, 2021, Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Minnesota.
2. In June 2023, the Board received a report that the Physician Assistant Board of the State of California had acted against Respondent's physician assistant license in the State of California on May 24, 2023. Pursuant to the Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order ("CA Order"), Respondent's physician assistant license was surrendered.

3. The CA Order further alleged that Respondent engaged in the unlicensed practice of medicine, violated the law regarding medical corporations, committed acts of dishonesty or corruption, committed gross negligence in his care and treatment of patients, committed repeated negligent acts in his care and treatment of patients, and failed to maintain adequate and accurate medical records while working as the main provider and clinic administrator of a community clinic he owned in Huntington Park, California.

4. In October 2024, the Board received a report that Respondent's California Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA") registration was revoked due to action taken by another board or agency.

5. In April 2025, the Board received a report that the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants ("NCCPA") imposed a non-permanent certification revocation on July 17, 2024, effective date of August 17, 2024, on Respondent based on the CA Order.

6. Respondent failed to report the CA Order and NCCPA certification revocation to the Board as required.

7. The Board attempted to contact Respondent for a response to the reports four separate times. On June 13, 2025, as part of its investigation into the above-referenced allegations, the Committee mailed an Amended Notice of Conference ("Notice") to the address Respondent placed on file with the Board, scheduling a conference for August 4, 2025. The Notice required a written response to the allegations by June 23, 2025.

8. Respondent failed to respond to the Notice and failed to attend the August 4, 2025 conference or notify the Committee that he would be unable to attend.

## CONCLUSIONS

The Board has reviewed the record of this proceeding and accepts the December 4, 2025, ALJ's Report and adopts and incorporates the conclusions of law therein. Accordingly, the Board makes the following Conclusions:<sup>1</sup>

1. The Board and the Administrative Law Judge have jurisdiction in this matter under Minnesota Statutes sections 147A.13 and 14.50 (2024).

2. The Respondent received timely and proper notice of the prehearing conference in this matter when the Board sent the Notice and Order for Hearing to his last known address.

3. The Board has complied with all relevant procedural requirements of law and rule.

4. Under Minnesota Rule 1400.6000, the Respondent is in default as a result of his failure to appear at the scheduled prehearing conference.

5. Under Minnesota Rule 1400.6000, when a party defaults by failing to appear at a prehearing conference without the prior consent of the judge, the allegations and the issues set out in the Notice and Order for Prehearing Conference and Hearing may be taken as true and deemed proven. The Board deems the allegations to be true.

6. Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13 provides that the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice may discipline a licensee who engages in conduct that violates the rules or law applicable to a licensee.

7. Respondent was alleged to have exhibited conduct constituting the following grounds for disciplinary action under Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13:

a. Was the subject of revocation, suspension, restriction, limitations, or other disciplinary action against the person's physician assistant credentials in another state or jurisdiction, failure to report to the board that charges regarding the person's credentials have been brought in another state or jurisdiction, or having been refused licensure by any other state or jurisdiction, in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13, subdivision 1(4);

b. Engaged in any unethical conduct; conduct likely to deceive, defraud, or harm the public, or demonstrating a willful or careless disregard for the health, welfare, or safety of a patient; or practice which is professionally incompetent, in that it may create unnecessary danger to any patient's life, health, or safety, in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13, subdivision 1(7);

c. Engaged in unprofessional conduct, including any departure from or the failure to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing practice, in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13, subdivision 1(10); and

d. Failed to cooperate with an investigation of the board as required by section 147A.15, subdivision 3, in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13, subdivision 1(19).

9. Based upon the allegations contained in the Notice and Order for Hearing, the Board has grounds to take disciplinary action against the Respondent's license.

10. When the Board finds that a licensed physician assistant has violated a provision or provisions of Minnesota Statutes sections 147A.01-.35 (2024), it may impose discipline, including suspension of the license. *See* Minnesota Statutes section 147A.16.

11. An order by the Board taking disciplinary action against the Respondent's license is in the public interest.

## ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions, the Board issues the following Order:

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent's license is **SUSPENDED** as of the date of this Order.

2. During the period of suspension, Respondent shall not engage in any conduct which would be grounds for suspension or revocation of his license pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13 ("Prohibited Conduct"). Respondent shall further not engage in any manner conduct that constitutes the practice of physician assistant, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 147A.03.

3. Respondent's license may be reinstated, if at all, as the evidence dictates and based upon the need to protect the public. The burden of proof shall be upon Respondent to demonstrate by a preponderance of the evidence that he is capable of conducting himself in a fit and competent manner as physician assistant. During the time of suspension, Respondent shall do the following: Respondent may petition for reinstatement of an unconditional license no sooner than 24 months from the date this Order. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, Respondent shall appear before the Committee to discuss his petition and his future practice plans. Upon hearing Respondent's petition, the Complaint Review Committee may recommend that the Board continue, modify, remove, or impose conditions and restrictions as deemed necessary. Upon reviewing Respondent's petition, the Board may continue, modify, or remove the suspension or impose conditions or restrictions as deemed necessary.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board may, at any regularly scheduled meeting following Respondent's petition, take any of the following actions:

- a. Issue an unconditional license to Respondent;
- b. Grant Respondent a license subject to conditions or restrictions;
- c. Upon Respondent's request, grant the cancellation of Respondent's credentials under disciplinary order pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 147.0381; or
- d. Continue the suspension of Respondent's license.

This matter came on for a prehearing conference before Administrative Law Judge Christa L. Moseng on November 6, 2025.

Carlos Figari, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Complaint Review Committee (Committee) of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice (Board). There was no appearance by, or on behalf of, Respondent Charles K. Sangmoah (Respondent).

On November 6, 2025, the Administrative Law Judge received a motion from the Committee requesting that a default recommendation be issued pursuant to Minn. R. 1400.6000 (2025) because there was no appearance by Respondent at the Prehearing Conference. Respondent did not file a response to the Committee's motion. The record in this matter closed on November 21, 2025.

**STATEMENT OF THE ISSUES**

1. Whether Respondent engaged in conduct that constitutes grounds for disciplinary action, particularly:
  - i. was the subject of revocation, suspension, restriction, limitations, or other disciplinary action against the person's physician assistant credentials in another state or jurisdiction, failure to report to the board that charges regarding the person's credentials have been brought in another state or jurisdiction, or having been refused licensure by any other state or jurisdiction, in violation of Minn. Stat. § 147A.13, subd. 1(4);
  - ii. engaged in any unethical conduct; conduct likely to deceive, defraud, or harm the public, or demonstrating a willful or careless disregard for the health, welfare, or safety of a patient; or practice which is professionally incompetent, in that it may create

unnecessary danger to any patient's life, health, or safety, in violation of Minn. Stat. § 147A.13, subd. 1(7);

- iii. engaged in unprofessional conduct, including any departure from or the failure to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing practice, in violation of Minn. Stat. § 147A.13, subd. 1(10); or,
- iv. failed to make reports as required by section 147A.14, and to cooperate with an investigation of the board as required by section 147A.15, subd. 3, in violation of Minn. Stat. § 147A.13, subd. 1(19).

### **SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATION**

The Judge concludes that Respondent is in default and recommends that the allegations in the Notice and Order for Prehearing Conference and Hearing (Notice and Order for Hearing) be accepted as true and deemed proven.

Based on the evidence in the hearing record, the Judge makes the following:

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On October 9, 2025, a Notice and Order for Hearing in this matter was mailed to Respondent at his last known address.<sup>1</sup>
2. The Notice and Order for Hearing indicated that a prehearing conference would be held in this matter on November 6, 2025, at 9:30 a.m., via telephone.<sup>2</sup>
3. In conformity with Minn. R. 1400.5700 (2025), the Notice and Order for Hearing states:<sup>3</sup>

**YOU MUST APPEAR FOR THE PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND THE HEARING TO PROTECT YOUR RIGHTS.** The Prehearing Conference is an opportunity for you to ask any questions you may have and to schedule deadlines. The Hearing is your opportunity to tell your side of the story and to challenge the Committee's allegations. A Notice of Appearance form is enclosed with this Notice. You must sign and send the Notice of Appearance to the Court of Administrative Hearings within twenty (20) days of the date of service of this Notice. You must also send the Notice of Appearance to the Committee's attorney.

4. In conformity with Minn. R. 1400.6000, the Notice and Order for Hearing in this matter also includes the following statement:

You are required to appear for the Pre-Hearing Conference and the Hearing. If you do not appear, the Committee will ask the Judge to find you in default. A default means that the Judge could deem the allegations contained in this Notice to be true and proven, which would allow the Board to take further disciplinary action against your license.

5. Respondent did not file a Notice of Appearance with the undersigned.

6. No one appeared at the November 6, 2025 Prehearing Conference on behalf of Respondent. No request was made for a continuance, nor was any communication received by the undersigned from Respondent prior to the November 6, 2025 Prehearing Conference.

7. Respondent's failure to appear at the prehearing conference was without consent of the Administrative Law Judge.

8. Because Respondent failed to appear at the prehearing conference, Respondent is in default.

9. Pursuant to Minn. R. 1400.6000, the allegations contained in the Notice and Order for Hearing, appended hereto as Attachment A, are taken as true, deemed proven without further evidence, and incorporated by reference into these Findings of Fact.

Based on the Findings of Fact, the Judge makes the following:

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Board and the Judge have jurisdiction in this matter under Minn. Stat. §§ 14.50 and 147.091 (2024).

2. The Respondent received timely and proper notice of the prehearing conference in this matter when the Board sent the Notice and Order for Hearing to his last known address.

3. The Board has complied with all relevant procedural requirements of statute and rule.

4. Under Minn. R. 1400.6000, the Respondent is in default as a result of his failure to appear at the scheduled prehearing conference.

5. Under Minn. R. 1400.6000, when a party defaults by failing to appear at a prehearing conference without the prior consent of the judge, the allegations and the issues set out in the Notice and Order for Prehearing Conference and Hearing may be taken as true and deemed proven. The Judge deems the allegations to be true.

6. Minnesota Statutes section 147.091 provides that the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice may discipline a licensee who engages in conduct that violates the rules or law applicable to a licensee.

7. Based upon the allegations contained in the Notice and Order for Hearing, the Board has grounds to take disciplinary action against the Respondent's license.


8. An order by the Board taking disciplinary action against the Respondent's license is in the public interest.

## **ALLEGATIONS**

1. On September 16, 2021, Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Minnesota.

2. In June 2023, the Board received a report that the Physician Assistant Board of the State of California had acted against Respondent's physician assistant license in the State of California on May 24, 2023. Pursuant to the Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order ("CA Order"), Respondent's physician assistant license was surrendered.

3. The CA Order further alleged that Respondent engaged in the unlicensed practice of medicine, violated the law regarding medical corporations, committed acts of dishonesty or corruption, committed gross negligence in his care and treatment of patients, committed repeated negligent acts in his care and treatment of patients, and failed to maintain adequate and accurate medical records while working as the main provider and clinic administrator of a community clinic he owned in Huntington Park, California.

4. In October 2024, the Board received a report that Respondent's California Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA") registration was revoked due to action taken by another board or agency.

5. In April 2025, the Board received a report that the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants ("NCCPA") imposed a non-permanent certification revocation on July 17, 2024, effective date of August 17, 2024, on Respondent based on the CA Order.

6. Respondent failed to report the CA Order and NCCPA certification revocation to the Board as required.

7. The Board attempted to contact Respondent for a response to the reports four separate times. On June 13, 2025, as part of its investigation into the above-referenced allegations, the Committee mailed an Amended Notice of Conference ("Notice") to the address Respondent placed on file with the Board, scheduling a conference for August 4, 2025. The Notice required a written response to the allegations by June 23, 2025.

8. Respondent failed to respond to the Notice and failed to attend the August 4, 2025 conference or notify the Committee that he would be unable to attend.

## **ISSUES**

Whether the forgoing conduct constitutes one or more of the following grounds for disciplinary action:

1. Was the subject of revocation, suspension, restriction, limitations, or other disciplinary action against the person's physician assistant credentials in another state or jurisdiction, failure to report to the board that charges regarding the person's credentials have been

brought in another state or jurisdiction, or having been refused licensure by any other state or jurisdiction, in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13, subdivision 1(4).

2. Engaged in any unethical conduct; conduct likely to deceive, defraud, or harm the public, or demonstrating a willful or careless disregard for the health, welfare, or safety of a patient; or practice which is professionally incompetent, in that it may create unnecessary danger to any patient's life, health, or safety, in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13, subdivision 1(7).

3. Engaged in unprofessional conduct, including any departure from or the failure to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing practice, in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13, subdivision 1(10).

4. Failed to make reports as required by section 147A.14, and to cooperate with an investigation of the board as required by section 147A.15, subdivision 3, in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 147A.13, subdivision 1(19).

#### **ADDITIONAL NOTICE**

1. Your failure to appear at the Prehearing Conference, Settlement Conference, or Hearing may result in a finding that you are in default. A default means that the allegations contained in this Notice of Hearing may be taken as true or deemed proved without further evidence needing to be presented. If the allegations are taken as true or deemed proved, the Committee may recommend disciplinary action, which may be imposed by the full Board.

2. If any party has good cause for requesting a delay of the Hearing, the request must be made in writing to the Administrative Law Judge at least five (5) days prior to the Prehearing Conference or Hearing. A copy of the request must be served on the other party.

3. Any party intending to appear at the Prehearing Conference and Hearing must file a Notice of Appearance form and return it to the Administrative Law Judge within twenty (20) days of the date of service of this Notice and Order for Hearing. A copy must be served on the Board's Committee attorney. A Notice of Appearance form is enclosed.

4. At the Hearing, all parties have the right to be represented by legal counsel, by themselves, or by a person of their choice (if not prohibited as the unauthorized practice of law). The parties are entitled to ask the Administrative Law Judge to issue subpoenas to compel witnesses to attend the Hearing. The parties will have the opportunity to be heard orally, to present evidence and cross-examine witnesses, and to submit evidence and argument. Ordinarily the Hearing is tape-recorded. The parties may request that a court reporter record the testimony at their expense.

5. Persons attending the Hearing should bring all evidence bearing on the case, including any records or other documents. If data that is not public is admitted into the record, it may become public data unless an objection is made and relief is requested under

Minnesota Statutes section 14.60, subdivision 2. The Board's disciplinary hearings are closed to the public.

6. Requests for subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses or the production of documents at the Hearing shall be made in writing to the Administrative Law Judge pursuant to Minnesota Rule 1400.7000. A copy of the subpoena request shall be served on the other parties. 7. This case may be appropriate for mediation. The parties are encouraged to consider requesting the Chief Administrative Law Judge assign a mediator so that mediation can be scheduled promptly.

The Court of Administrative Hearings conducts contested case proceedings in accordance with the Minnesota Rules of Professional Conduct and the Professionalism Aspirations adopted by the Minnesota Supreme Court. **AGREEMENT FOR  
CORRECTIVE ACTION**

This Agreement for Corrective Action (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between Casey McManus Woster, M.D., (“Respondent”), and the Complaint Review Committee of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice (“Committee”) pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statutes section 214.103, subdivision 6(a) (2024). Respondent has been advised by Board representatives that he may choose to be represented by legal counsel in this matter. Respondent elected to be represented by Sarah M. Hoffman, Bassford Remele, 100 South Fifth Street, Suite 1500, Minneapolis, Minnesota, 55402-1254. The Committee was represented by Nicholas Lienesch and Carly Rasmussen, Assistant Attorneys General, 445 Minnesota Street, Suite 600, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101. Respondent and the Committee hereby agree as follows:

**FACTS**

1. For the purpose of this Agreement, the Board may consider the following facts as true:
  - a. Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota on March 10, 2012. Respondent is board certified in emergency medicine.
  - b. In April 2024, the Board received notice that a medical malpractice settlement was made on Respondent’s behalf related to a claim of failure to diagnose pregnancy and eclampsia in a patient (“Patient #1) who had recently been diagnosed with hypertension and

presented to the emergency department (“ED”) after experiencing a seizure. Six weeks after presenting to the ED, Patient #1 delivered a stillborn fetus with a gestational age in the third trimester. Respondent was the attending physician in the ED overseeing Patient #1’s care. Respondent did not order a pregnancy test or consider eclampsia as the cause of Patient #1’s seizures.

c. On September 25, 2025, Respondent appeared before the Committee to discuss the allegations. Respondent explained that Patient #1 arrived at the ED via EMS. Patient #1 was post-ictal in the ED, and was unable to provide a detailed history of what happened. Respondent explained that he focused on managing Patient #1’s seizures and hypertension, as well as the possibility of intracranial bleeding. Respondent explained that Patient #1 received medications to treat her seizures and hypertension, and that her seizures stopped. In addition, Patient #1 underwent a CT scan of the head during her time in the ED, and that exam did not show any evidence of intracranial bleeding. Respondent explained that Patient #1 was admitted to Hospital Medicine, and was ultimately discharged after expert consultation with a diagnosis of hypertension and PRES. Respondent also explained that unfortunately, Patient #1 did not know that she was pregnant, and there was no visual evidence of pregnancy. However, Respondent acknowledged that a diagnosis of pregnancy should have been made. Respondent also acknowledged the importance of obtaining objective data when circumstances indicate that a patient may be an unreliable historian.

2. Based on the discussion, the Committee views Respondent’s conduct as inappropriate under Minnesota Statutes 147.091, subdivision 1(k) (2024), and Respondent agrees that the conduct cited above constitutes a reasonable basis in law and fact to justify corrective action under these statutes.

### CORRECTIVE ACTION

3. Respondent agrees to address the concerns referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 by taking the following corrective action:

a. Within six months of the date of the Agreement, Respondent shall successfully complete pre-approved coursework in:

- i. High-Risk Obstetrics Review; and
- ii. Anchor Bias.

b. Within three months of successful completion of the above-referenced coursework, Respondent shall write and submit a paper, for review and approval by the Committee, discussing what Respondent has learned from the coursework and how he will implement this knowledge into his practice; and

c. This Agreement shall be satisfied upon Respondent's successful completion of the terms of the Agreement.

4. This Agreement shall become effective upon execution by the Committee and shall remain in effect until Respondent successfully completes the terms of the Agreement. Successful completion shall be determined by the Committee. Upon Respondent's signature and the Committee's execution of this Agreement, the Committee agrees to close the complaints resulting in the information referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2. Respondent understands and further agrees that if, after the matter has been closed, the Committee receives additional complaints similar to the information in paragraphs 1 and 2, the Committee may reopen the closed complaint.

5. If Respondent fails to satisfy the terms of the Agreement the Committee may, in its discretion, reopen the investigation and proceed according to Minnesota Statutes chapters 14, 147, and 214. Failure to satisfy the terms of the Agreement constitutes failure to cooperate under


Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1(u). In any subsequent proceeding, the Committee may use this Agreement as proof that Respondent's conduct, cited in the Facts above, justified action under these statutes.

6. Respondent understands that this Agreement does not constitute disciplinary action. Respondent further understands and acknowledges that this Agreement and any letter of satisfaction are classified as public data for purposes of Minnesota Statutes sections 13.02, subdivision 15, and 13.41, subdivision 5 (2024). Data regarding this Agreement may be provided to data banks as required by federal law or consistent with Board policy.

7. Respondent acknowledges reading and understanding this Agreement and entering into it voluntarily. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the Committee and Respondent, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this Agreement.

**AGREEMENT FOR  
CORRECTIVE ACTION**

This Agreement for Corrective Action (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between Jason Thomas Lee, L.Ac. (“Respondent”), and the Complaint Review Committee of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice (“Committee”) pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statutes section 214.103, subdivision 6(a) (2024). Respondent was represented by Nicole L. Brand, Meagher + Geer, P.L.L.P., 33 South Sixth Street, Suite 4300, Minneapolis, Minnesota 55402. The Committee was represented by Nicholas Lienesch and Jamal Zayed, Assistant Attorneys General, 445 Minnesota Street, Suite 600, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101. Respondent and the Committee hereby agree as follows:

**FACTS**

1. For the purpose of this Agreement, the Board may consider the following facts as true:
  - a. Respondent was licensed to practice as an acupuncturist in the State of Minnesota on January 9, 2016.
  - b. In March 2024, the Board received a complaint stating Respondent engaged in inappropriate physical and verbal behavior with Patient #1 including sharing personal information and providing manual treatment without prior explanation.

c. On June 26, 2025, Respondent appeared before the Committee to discuss the allegations. During the conference, Respondent indicated that he did not ask follow-up questions when Patient #1 disclosed a history of past trauma. In a written statement to the Committee, Respondent acknowledged that had shared personal stories with patients when relevant to treatment and recollected sharing with Patient #1 a photo of individuals who they may know in common.

2. Based on the discussion, the Committee views Respondent's conduct as inappropriate under Minnesota Statutes sections 147B.07 and 147.091, subdivision 1 (g) (engaged in any unethical or improper conduct) (2024), and Respondent agrees that the conduct cited above constitutes a reasonable basis in law and fact to justify corrective action under these statutes.

### **CORRECTIVE ACTION**

3. Respondent agrees to address the concerns referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 by taking the following corrective action:

a. Within one year of the date of the Agreement, Respondent shall successfully complete pre-approved coursework in:

- i. Professional Boundaries, and
- ii. Trauma informed care.

b. Within three months of completing the above-referenced coursework, Respondent shall write a paper, for Committee approval, documenting what he has learned from his coursework and how he will implement that knowledge into his practice.

c. This Agreement shall be satisfied upon Respondent's successful completion of the terms of the Agreement.

4. This Agreement shall become effective upon execution by the Committee and shall remain in effect until Respondent successfully completes the terms of the Agreement. Successful completion shall be determined by the Committee. Upon Respondent's signature and the Committee's execution of this Agreement, the Committee agrees to close the complaints resulting in the information referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2. Respondent understands and further agrees that if, after the matter has been closed, the Committee receives additional complaints similar to the information in paragraphs 1 and 2, the Committee may reopen the closed complaint.


5. If Respondent fails to satisfy the terms of the Agreement the Committee may, in its discretion, reopen the investigation and proceed according to Minnesota Statutes chapters 14, 147, and 214. Failure to satisfy the terms of the Agreement constitutes failure to cooperate under Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1(u). In any subsequent proceeding, the Committee may use this Agreement as proof that Respondent's conduct, cited in the Facts above, justified action under these statutes.


6. Respondent understands that this Agreement does not constitute disciplinary action. Respondent further understands and acknowledges that this Agreement and any letter of satisfaction are classified as public data for purposes of Minnesota Statutes sections 13.02, subdivision 15, and 13.41, subdivision 5 (2024). Data regarding this Agreement may be provided to data banks as required by federal law or consistent with Board policy.

7. Respondent acknowledges reading and understanding this Agreement and entering into it voluntarily. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the Committee and Respondent, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this Agreement.

**AGREEMENT FOR  
CORRECTIVE ACTION**

This Agreement for Corrective Action (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between Michael James Norgard, M.D. (“Respondent”), and the Complaint Review Committee of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice (“Committee”) pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statutes section 214.103, subdivision 6(a) (2024). Respondent has been advised by Board representatives that he may choose to be represented by legal counsel in this matter. Respondent elected to be represented by Angela E. Lord, Vogel Law Firm, 218 Northern Pacific Avenue, Fargo, North Dakota 58102. The Committee was represented by Carlos Figari, Assistant Attorney General, 445 Minnesota Street, Suite 600, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101. Respondent and the Committee hereby agree as follows:

**FACTS**

1. For the purpose of this Agreement, the Board may consider the following facts as true:
  - a. Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota on July 11, 1998. Respondent is board certified in obstetrics and gynecology.
  - b. In February 2024, the Board received a complaint indicating that Respondent was asked to resign from a former partnership due to professionalism issues relating

to peer-to-peer communications and failure to maintain a respectful workplace. The Board reviewed a sample of Respondent's patient medical records and noted deficiencies in Respondent's patient care with respect to medical recordkeeping, patient hand-off, and patient follow-up.

c. On January 5, 2026, Respondent appeared before the Committee to discuss the allegations. Respondent admitted to communication and interpersonal difficulties with colleagues at his former practice and acknowledged that there may not have been adequate hand-offs because of the difficulties. Respondent acknowledged that some patients may not have received appropriate follow-up but attributed this oversight to him leaving his former practice. Respondent confirmed his understanding that it is the physician's responsibility to ensure patient test results are reviewed and communicated in a timely manner to the patient. Respondent further admitted that his discussions with patients were often excluded in patient records.

2. Based on the discussion, the Committee views Respondent's conduct as inappropriate under Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1 (g) (engaged in unethical or improper conduct); and (k) (engaged in conduct that departs from or fails to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing medical practice in which case proof of actual injury need not be established) (2024). Respondent agrees that the conduct cited above constitutes a reasonable basis in law and fact to justify corrective action under these statutes.

### **CORRECTIVE ACTION**

3. Respondent agrees to address the concerns referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 by taking the following corrective action:

a. Within nine months of the date of the Agreement, Respondent shall successfully complete the following pre-approved courses:

i. Communication with Colleagues; and

ii. Medical Record Keeping.

b. Within three months of successful completion of the above-referenced coursework, he shall write and submit a paper, for review and approval by the Committee, discussing what he has learned from the coursework and how he will implement this knowledge into his practice; and

c. This Agreement shall be satisfied upon Respondent's successful completion of the terms of the Agreement.


