**ORDER OF REMOVAL OF  
STAY OF SUSPENSION**

This matter came on before the Complaint Review Committee (“Committee”) of the Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine (“Board”) in accordance with the terms of a February 9, 2010, Amended Stipulation and Order (“2010 Amended Order”), which Kathryn E. Marr, D.V.M. (“Respondent”), agreed to and signed.

Pursuant to the 2010 Amended Order, Respondent’s license was suspended, but the suspension was stayed contingent upon Respondent’s compliance with all terms and conditions set forth in the 2010 Amended Order. In paragraph K. of the 2010 Amended Order, Respondent expressly acknowledged and agreed the Committee is authorized to issue an Order of Removal of Stay of Suspension (“Order of Removal”) if it has probable cause to believe Respondent has failed to comply with or has violated any of the requirements for staying the suspension of Respondent’s license.

The Committee has probable cause to believe Respondent has failed to comply with or has violated one or more of the requirements for staying the suspension of Respondent’s license.

**ORDER**

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stay of suspension set forth in the 2010 Amended Order is **REMOVED**, and the license of Respondent as a veterinarian in the State of Minnesota is **SUSPENDED** immediately.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent’s license as a veterinarian in the State of Minnesota shall remain suspended until the Board makes a final determination in this matter.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent surrender to the Board her veterinary medicine license. Respondent shall personally deliver or mail the certificate to the Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine, c/o John King, Executive Director, Suite 540, 2829 University Avenue S.E., Minneapolis, Minnesota 55414, within five days after receipt by Respondent of this Order.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's violation of this Order shall provide grounds for further disciplinary action pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 156.081, subdivision 2(12) (2008).

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board may, at any regularly scheduled meeting following service of this Order of Removal and a Notice of Removal of Stay of Suspension, Imposition of Suspension, and Hearing upon Respondent in accordance with the requirements of the 2010 Amended Order, take any of the following actions:

a. Dismiss the Committee's allegations and reinstate Respondent's license under the terms of the 2010 Amended Order.

b. Reinstate Respondent's license with limitations placed upon the scope of Respondent's practice and/or conditional upon further reports to the Board.

c. Continue the suspension of Respondent's license.
