ORDER OF SUSPENSION

- 1. The Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine ("Board") is authorized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes chapter 156 to regulate persons who are licensed as veterinarians in the State of Minnesota, and further is authorized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes sections 214.10 and 214.103 to review complaints against licensed veterinarians and to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.
- 2. Angela M. Marthaler ("Licensee") is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which she holds a license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota.
- 3. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 214.101, subdivisions 1 and 4, the license of a veterinarian must be suspended if the licensee is found by a court, administrative law judge or public authority to be in arrears in child support or maintenance payments or both.
- 4. On May 25, 2023, the Board received notification from the Child Support Services office in Windom, Minnesota, that Licensee is in arrears in court-ordered child support and under Minnesota Statutes sections 214.101 and 518A.66 the Board must suspend Licensee's license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota.
- 5. The authority to sign orders suspending licenses pursuant to Minnesota Statutes sections 214.101 and 518A.66 has been delegated to the Executive Director of the Board.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Licensee's license to practice veterinary

medicine in the State of Minnesota shall be SUSPENDED, effective immediately. During

the period of suspension, Licensee shall not engage in the practice of veterinary medicine

as defined by Minnesota Statutes 156.001, subdivision 11, and 156.12, subdivision 1 in the

State of Minnesota.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Licensee is in possession of her current 2.

license renewal certificate, Licensee shall surrender and personally deliver or mail the

certificate to Dr. Julia Wilson, Executive Director, Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine,

2829 University Avenue Southeast, Suite 401, Minneapolis, Minnesota 55414, within ten

days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the suspension shall remain in effect until 3.

such time as the Board receives notification from the court, administrative law judge, or

public authority that referred this matter to the Board confirming that Licensee is not in

arrears in either child support or maintenance payments or confirming that Licensee is in

compliance with a written payment plan regarding both current support and arrearages.
