ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL
LICENSE

The Minnesota Board of Psychology (Board) convened on March 21, 2014, to review the petition of Mary D. Nelson, MA, LP (Licensee) for removal of the conditions placed on her license by a Stipulation and Consent Order, adopted and implemented by the Board on January 18, 2013 (January 2013 Order). Having considered the Complaint Resolution Committee's (Committee) recommendation that Licensee be granted an unconditional license, the Board determines that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled all conditions set forth in the January 2013 Order as follows:

1. Pursuant to page 2, paragraph 4.a., within Licensee shall practice psychology only under the supervision of a supervising psychologist, meeting with the supervisor no less than two (2) hours per month for a period of no less than twelve (12) months.
2. Pursuant to page 3, paragraph 4.b., the supervising psychologist shall provide a report to the Committee every three (3) months and at the time Licensee petitions to have the supervision condition removed from her license.
3. Pursuant to page 4, paragraph 4.c., within twelve (12) months of the date the Order, Licensee shall enroll in and complete an individualized professional boundaries course.
4. Pursuant to page 4, paragraph 4.d., within thirty (30) days of completing the boundaries course, Licensee shall submit a report on the course.

5. Pursuant to page 5, paragraph 5.e., within sixty (60) days of completing the boundaries course, Licensee shall cause to be submitted a report on the course from the instructor.

The Committee received documentation verifying Licensee's compliance with the remedy listed in paragraphs 4.a. through 4.e. and all subsequent paragraphs of the January 2013 Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

ORDER

Licensee shall be granted an **UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE** to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
