Dr. Chawla along with several other Board Members spoke briefly about Dr. Spaulding's time with the Board and reflected on her leadership navigating some significant transitions and her warm welcoming of new Board members. Dr. Spaulding thanked the Board members for their kind and generous words.

Agenda Item 4: Presentation by Teri Fritsma, Ph.D. "Minnesota's Physician, Physician Assistant, and Respiratory Therapist Workforce"

Dr. Chawla introduced Teri Fritsma, Ph. D, Lead Healthcare Workforce Analyst at the Minnesota Department of Health, Office of Rural Health and Primary Care. Dr. Fritsma provided a presentation including an in-depth discussion around understanding the licensed healthcare workforce in Minnesota. Dr. Fritsma noted the core of the work her office does is around access to care for Minnesotans. She added that data is collected from approximately 30 licensed health care professionals.

During and following the presentation, Dr. Fritsma answered several questions from Board members and offered to share some additional information with Board members based on their questions and the content of the conversation after the meeting.

Elizabeth Huntley shared the HPSP Program Committee Report, including that the Office of Cannabis Management provided an extensive presentation around their work at the meeting. The materials from the August 12, 2025, Program Committee meeting were included in the Board agenda.

Agenda Item 7: Appointment of Nominating Committee

Dr. Chawla requested that if any Board members would like to be on the Nominating Committee to please let her know. She also invited any Board members interested in being a Board Officer for 2026 to also reach out to her directly. Dr. Chawla asked if anyone would like to volunteer to be on the Nominating Committee and Mr. Manahan, Dr. Sutor and Ms. Turner each volunteered.

Agenda Item 8: Recommendation for Commissioner to the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact

Mr. Manahan, one of Minnesota's Commissioners to the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact, second term on the Board expires in January 2026, and so does his appointment to the Commission. Therefore, the Board is looking for a new Commissioner for the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact. Dr. Chawla asked Mr. Manahan to provide background on what the Compact does and what role Commissioners play in the work of the Compact.

Mr. Manahan provided a background on the establishment of the Commission, including that every participating state has two Commissioners and typically one of those Commissioners is a member of the staff of the Board, for Minnesota that Commissioner is Executive Director Huntley. He added that typically, the second Commissioner is a Board Member. The basic principle of the Commission is that every state should have the right to regulate who practices medicine in that state. The primary role of the Compact is to streamline the process by which individual physicians get licensed in more than one state or territory.

Leopold Arko IV, M.D., MS., FAANS, and Jane Willett, D.O., each expressed interest to serve as a Commissioner from Minnesota.

Dr. Chawla recognized and thanked Mr. Manahan for his work on and commitment to the Compact.

Agenda Item 9: Executive Director's Report

Ms. Huntley shared her Executive Director's Report.

Ms. Huntley thanked Eden Young for her tremendous work and partnership to close out fiscal year 25 and launch the Board into fiscal year 26.

Ms. Huntley noted an upcoming meeting with the financial management team through SmART, Department of Administration, to review the Board's financial status and to ensure we are understanding and aware of any unique situations that might be presenting this fiscal year. The meeting is also essential to building and maintaining a trusted relationship with our partners at SmART.

The Federation of State Medical Boards, (FSMB), once again offered a three-part series over summer titled "New Board Member Training". Some of the topics covered during those three modules included the foundational aspects of professional regulation, a legal overview, policy making, accountability, licensing, disciplinary process as well as ethics and professionalism. The series was well received, and Ms. Huntley anticipates it will be offered again next summer. Ms. Huntley thank the Board Members who were able to attend some of the sessions as schedules permitted.

IAMRA, the International Association of Medical Regulatory Authorities, hosted its 16th international conference on medical regulation last week in Dublin. Ireland. With the Board's support, Ms. Huntley was able to attend the conference, and she reported it was a collective effort to bring together regulators, health professionals, policy makers and researchers to explore current and emerging issues in the regulation of physicians. The conference theme was, "People Focused Regulation for a Safer Global Community," and there were 462 attendees representing 37 countries. The conference kicked off with presentations and discussions around community expectations and what leadership looks like in the role of regulation and the spaces of both health and social care, intertwined with public policy. There was a strong focus on patient safety while recognizing the inevitable and avoidable harm that comes with healthcare. A lot of conversation was had around how to optimize people, processes and systems, working together and what barriers exist for patient engagement.

Ms. Huntley shared there was also had a session on the transformation of regulation in tomorrow's era of digital and personalized health care. The focus here was not just on artificial intelligence but also through the lens of trustworthiness and regulation. The final general session was around compassion and compassionate leadership and regulation with a very strong emphasis on the importance of trust and transparency.

During the conference, Ms. Huntley had the opportunity to present with two colleagues from the Federation of State Medical Boards with a session titled, "Streamlining Licensure to Enhance Access and Safety in Telemedicine, a US Perspective on People Centered Regulation." Ms. Huntley's focus was about the IMLCC and the impact that it has had both in Minnesota and for all the 42 participating jurisdictions, as well as about Minnesota's interstate practice of telemedicine for patients located in Minnesota with healthcare providers located in other states.

Ms. Huntley thanked the Board of their support of her participation at the conference.

Ms. Huntley shared that Kita Nelson and Ger Lo from the Licensure Unit will be attending the final session of a nine-month training that they have participated in to earn their Certified Medical Board Licensing Specialist certificate. This is an effort offered through Administrators in Medicine and Ms. Huntley thanked Ms. Nelson and Ms. Lo for their curiosity and commitment to growth and development in the licensing and regulatory spaces.

Ms. Huntley acknowledged Dr. Krohn and thanked her and her colleagues from the University of Minnesota for once again allowing for the Board's participation in an interactive lesson at the end of August for fourth year medical students. This was an effort originally presented in the summer of 2024 in collaboration with HPSP. Dr. Krohn added the session was completely asynchronous and shared a summary of what the session included.

Ms. Huntley offered a brief update on a case in federal court, that names some people in both their individual and official capacities and then several Jane Rose and John Does in their capacities as Board members. The case was dismissed in district court for a second time earlier this year in our favor. At the end of June, the Plaintiff in this case filed a Brief in the 8th Circuit Court of Appeals and we provided our Reply Brief last month. Ms. Huntley noted she will keep Board members posted on developments of this case.

Ms. Huntley invited Board members to share ideas for educational sessions for future Board meetings.

Ms. Huntley acknowledged that earlier this week she was able to recognize a personal milestone in public service as she celebrated her 30-year anniversary of having the privilege of working for the people of Minnesota.

Ms. Huntley concluded her Executive Director's report.

Mr. Manahan briefly revisited his remarks regarding the work and role of the IMLC Compact, specifically noting the crucial role Board staff play, and that point, he graciously thanked Eden Young for the superb job she does dealing with issues as they present.

Julie Pazdernik, M.D., shared that she will be starting a psychiatry fellowship in October through the University of Massachusetts. The focus of the fellowship is to train primary care physicians in psychiatry. Katie L. Templeton, JD, Chair of the FSMB's Nominating Committee, invites FSMB Member Medical Boards to submit names of Board Member Fellows for the Nominating Committee to consider as candidates for elected office. Elections will be held at the FSMB's May 2, 2026, House of Delegates annual business meeting. Nominees may include physicians as well as non-physicians who are Board Member Fellows of the FSMB. Eligibility requirements, additional position-specific qualifications, responsibilities of elected positions, and necessary documentation are included on the following pages. **Please refer to this information when submitting your letters of nomination.**

Nomination Deadline

The Nominating Committee requests that all nominations be submitted by <u>11:59 pm CT</u> on <u>December 15, 2025</u>. <u>No nominations will be accepted after this deadline.</u>

Elected Positions

In accordance with the FSMB Bylaws, the Nominating Committee shall submit a roster of one or more candidates for each position. A candidate who runs for and is not elected to an elected office shall be ineligible to be nominated for any other elected office during the same election cycle. Positions to be filled in 2026 are as follows:

elect; one year as Chair; and one year as Immediate Past Chair

Directors-at-Large
 3 Board Member Fellows, each to be elected for a three-year term*/**

• Nominating Committee 3 Board Member Fellows, each to be elected for a two-year term***/****

*In accordance with the with the FSMB Bylaws, "At least three members of the Board, who are not Staff Fellows, shall be non-physicians, at least two of whom shall be a Member Medical Board public member." Currently, there are two non-physicians on the FSMB Board, who are Member Medical Board public members, who will continue serving through FY 2027 (May 2026-April 2027). Accordingly, it is required that one non-physician be elected in 2026; additional non-physicians may also be elected.

**Should a current Board member whose term does not expire in May 2026 be elected Chair-elect, then a 4th candidate will need to be elected to fill the remainder of that Board member's term.

***In accordance with the FSMB Bylaws, "At least one elected member of the Nominating Committee shall be a public member." Currently, there is one public member on the Nominating Committee, and that member's term will end in April 2027. Accordingly, although additional public members may be elected in 2026, it will not be required that a public member be elected this year.

****No two Nominating Committee members shall be from the same Member Medical Board. Continuing members of the Committee are from Michigan, Missouri, and West Virginia; therefore, no Nominating Committee candidates shall be from those Member Medical Boards.

Eligibility Requirements

Any person who is or will be a Board Member Fellow of the FSMB at the time of the election on Saturday, May 2, 2026, is eligible for nomination. In accordance with Bylaws Article II, Section B, "A Board Member Fellowis an individual member who as a result of appointment or confirmation is designated to be a member of a Member Medical Board. A Board Member Fellow shall be a Fellow of the FSMB during the member's period of service on a Member Medical Board, and for a period of thirty-six months thereafter."

A candidate for elected office should exhibit the following **Core Competencies**:

- Have a clear understanding of (and enthusiastically support) the vision, mission, and strategic goals of the FSMB (see attached FSMB Strategic Plan on page 7-8);
- Possess a positive outlook on the role and function of Member Medical Boards in the medical regulatory field;
- Bring a broad, national perspective to specific issues;
- Have adequate time and commitment necessary to fulfill the responsibilities of the office; and
- Demonstrate professionalism, personal integrity, and the ability to work effectively with others.

The following additional qualifications are suggested but not mandatory:

- **Chair-elect:** One or more years' experience on the FSMB Board of Directors and, if applicable, a commitment of time that may require reduction by one-third or more of patient care duties in medical practice.
- Board of Directors and Nominating Committee: 1) One or more years on a Member Medical Board, 2) FSMB committee or workgroup participation, and 3) prior attendance of <u>at least one</u> FSMB Annual Meeting.
- **Board of Directors:** Significant experience on a non-profit Board of Directors or Foundation may be considered an equivalent for one of the recommendations stated above.

Additionally, newly elected members of the Board will take part in the Investiture of the Board at the 2026 Annual Meeting on **Saturday**, **May 2**, and join the Board at its first meeting of the year on the following morning, **Sunday**, **May 3**.

Documentation Requirement

1. **Photograph – color (jpg).** A head shot of the nominee is preferred. Questions about photos may be directed to Manager, BOD Liaison and Governance Support, Lauren Mitchell at limitchell@fsmb.org.

2. Letter of Nomination

The letter of nomination <u>must</u> come from the nominee's Member Medical Board to the Nominating Committee and should specify: (1) the name of the nominee to be considered; (2) the office for which the nominee is being recommended; (3) a description of the nominee's ability to demonstrate the core competencies and/or additional position-specific qualifications stated above; (4) the nominee's agreement to the submission of his/her name for potential nomination; (5) the nominee's affirmation that he/she is aware of the time commitment required for the position to which he/she may be elected; and (6) the nominee's mailing address, daytime telephone number and email address.

- 3. **Personal Statement (sample on page 7) (maximum 500-word limit).** The nominee should state why the nominee wants to serve in the position for which the nominee will be campaigning for election; how the nominee fulfills the core competencies and/or additional position-specific qualifications, and what the nominee will contribute to FSMB.
- 4. **Bullet Points.** The nominee should submit <u>6-8</u> bullet points (<u>maximum 200-word limit</u>) reflecting accomplishments for which the nominee wishes to be recognized.
- CV Summary (<u>maximum 5 pages</u>) and/or bio. Please provide relevant information including the nominee's education, current profession, FSMB activities, important appointments, honors, awards, etc.
- 6. Candidate's Signatory Page (see "Documentation Submission" below). The nominee must submit an electronically signed confirmation that the nominee, if selected as a candidate: 1) will be a Board Member Fellow as defined by the FSMB Bylaws at the time of the election on Saturday, May 2, 2025;
 - 2) is aware of the time commitment required for the position to which the nominee may be elected; and
 - 3) is disclosing any potential conflict(s) of interest.

Please note that should the Nominating Committee select the nominee for inclusion in its roster of candidates, the photo and all documents submitted will be posted on the FSMB Annual Meeting Website, and some of the information included in the Election Manual that will be distributed to the Annual Meeting attendees. Social security numbers and all other private information must be removed from the documents prior to submission.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF ELECTED POSITIONS

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The FSMB Board of Directors is responsible for the control and administration of the FSMB and reports to the House of Delegates; the Board provides leadership in the development and implementation of the FSMB's Strategic Goals and the Board's Annual Action Plan; the Board is responsible for governing and conducting the business of the corporation, including supervising the President-CEO; and, under the leadership of the Chair and President-CEO, represents the FSMB to other organizations and promotes recognition of the FSMB as the premier organization concerned with medical licensure and discipline. The Board of Directors is the fiscal agent of the corporation.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The Board of Directors is responsible for the following:

- 1. Setting goals, objectives, and priorities necessary to achieve the FSMB Strategic Goals.
- 2. Setting goals, objectives, and critical success factors for the President-CEO.
- 3. Ensuring effective management of the FSMB's financial resources.
- 4. Approving systems for assessing and addressing needs of Member Medical Boards.
- 5. Implementing adopted Board of Directors professional development and self-assessment plans.
- 6. Promoting use of FSMB services among targeted customer groups.
- 7. Enhancing communication with and among Member Medical Boards.
- 8. Enhancing support and education for Member Medical Board executives and their staff.

Newly elected directors will be asked to participate in a New Directors Orientation **June 1-2, 2026** with the FSMB Chair, President-CEO and Executive Team either at the FSMB Euless, Texas offices. This will be preceded by a one-hour virtual session with FSMB support staff *(date TBD)*.

Subcommittees of the Board of Directors

All directors will be appointed to one (1) subcommittee of the Board of Directors, which include the Awards, Governance, and Planning Committees. Additionally, three (3) directors will be elected by the Board to participate on the Executive, Compensation, and Investment Committees with the officers of the Board.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The charge of the Nominating Committee as currently set forth in the FSMB Bylaws is to submit a roster of oneor more candidates for each of the offices and positions to be filled by election at the annual meeting of the House of Delegates. The Committee will communicate its roster of candidates to Member Medical Boards not fewer than sixty days prior to the annual meeting of the House of Delegates.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The Nominating Committee is responsible for the following:

- 1. Soliciting nominations from Member Medical Boards for Board Member Fellows interested in seekingan elected FSMB position;
- 2. Assertively recruiting individuals who have the core competencies set forth on page 2 and who representdiversified backgrounds, experiences, and cultures;
- 3. Educating potential candidates on core competencies for FSMB leadership roles and the responsibilities associated with respective leadership positions;
- 4. Reviewing letters of nomination and supporting material for each individual nominated or recruited as a candidate for election:
- 5. Verifying that candidates have the core competencies for FSMB leadership positions;
- Verifying that queries of the FSMB Physician Data Center have been completed on physician and physician assistant candidates and that no board actions have been reported that could call into questionan individual's fitness for FSMB leadership;
- 7. Affirming that all candidates for elected leadership have disclosed any potential conflicts of interest.
- 8. Considering the importance of public member representation on the FSMB Board of Directors and assure the roster of candidates provides for election of adequate/qualified public representation;
- 9. Selecting and narrowing the roster of candidates to those who best demonstrate the core competencies outlined; have the necessary qualifications and eligibility for a position; and bring valuable talents and perspectives to the FSMB;
- 10. Preparing a report to the House of Delegates, which includes a roster of candidates for positions to be filled by election at the House of Delegates annual business meeting; and
- 11. Determining process for notifying candidates of the Nominating Committee's decisions as soon as possible following the Committee's winter meeting and provide the Nominating Committee report to the FSMB Board of Directors for information.

TIME COMMITMENT

Members of the Nominating Committee serve a single two-year term. Our newly elected Nominating Committee members are invited to join the incoming Committee Chair, outgoing Committee Chair, FSMB President & CEO, returning members of the Nominating Committee, and those who are rotating off the Committee for an informal Nominating Committee Social (4:30-5:00 subject to change slightly) on Saturday, May 2, 2026, preceding the Inauguration of the Chair, during the Annual Meeting. The Committee will meet again via videoconference in August 2026, and April 2027 (dates TBD) as well as in person or via videoconference in January 2027. In preparation for the January meeting, the Committee members will each interview the nominees. Members of the Committee will also receive scholarships to attend the FSMB's 2027 Annual Meeting, so they are onsite to solicit membership interest in elected and appointed positions.

2025 PA Compact Commission Annual Report

Chair Corner

Lao Tzu said, "The journey of a thousand miles begins with a single step." It is a sentiment that is appropriate to the PA Compact. There have been a multitude of single steps from the Compact's conception in 2019, to its activation in May 2024, and the first official commission meeting in September 2024. Since that time the Compact's path seems to have moved at lightning speed, or painstakingly slow, depending on your perception.

As we look forward, we also need to look back at the accomplishments. Since the inaugural commission meeting, with 9 voting delegates, there has been a great deal of work, much of it unseen, accomplished. In addition to the executive committee, the commission has three working committees that meet regularly and will provide updates below.

The commission, thanks to our partners, has secured a basic level of funding to move forward. Now we are learning about database systems, how they work, what is needed to interact with state systems, and possible solutions including the use of existing databases or creating one from scratch. With the help of outside experts, the commission will soon be releasing an RFP to move the database project forward. Although it may seem like a slow process for those looking in from the outside, the amount of work accomplished in the past year is astounding. A firm foundation from which to grow has been created.

In ending this inaugural newsletter, I would be remiss not to thank my fellow commission delegates, alternates, ex-officio partners, and staff. This group is responsible for the creation of a new entity. Although similar to other compacts, it is also different. The time and effort they have expended to ensure a system that works seamlessly for PAs, state licensing boards and, most importantly, continues to provide a high level of public protection, is nothing short of amazing. Their work is mostly unseen to the outside world, but we owe them a huge debt of gratitude.

This is an exciting time. As we welcome new members and to build from the foundation that has been started, we will continue to move forward, one step at a time.

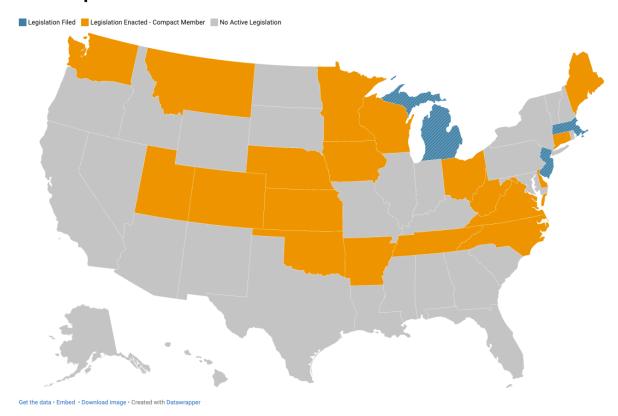

Committee Synopsis

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee is empowered to act on behalf of the Commission between Commission meetings, except for rulemaking or amendment of the compact. The committee consists of seven voting members who are elected by the Commission from the current membership of the Commission and two ex-officios, nonvoting members from one recognized national PA professional association and one recognized national PA certification organization. Kathy Scarbalis serves as ex-officio on behalf of the American Academy of Physician Associates, and Greg Thomas serves as ex-officio on behalf of the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants.

Since October 1, 2024, the Executive Committee has met eleven times. In March 2025, the committee received responses to a Data System RFI, and the full Commission



subsequently viewed presentations by four of the RFI respondents. From May to October 2025, the committee prepared Data System RFP for distribution.

Communications

The Communications Committee, in consultation with the Chair of the Commission and the Executive Director, is responsible for onboarding new participating state delegates and administrative staff; create press releases; suggest updates to the website and informational items to media sources; and create additional public relations documents and provide presentations regarding the work of the Commission if needed.

Since October 1, 2024, the Communications Committee has met six times. During that time, the committee created a PA Compact newsletter to be distributed quarterly; updated the PA Compact development timeline on PA Compact website; and reviewed and updated FAQs on PA Compact website.

Finance

The Finance Committee is responsible for providing financial oversight and ensure the Commission is operating within its budget; developing finance resources to achieve its purposes; propose fees as authorized in the Compact; investigate potential funding resources; and suggest a fiscal year for the Commission. The committee is chaired by the Treasurer of the Commission, who, with the assistance of the Executive Director of the Compact, serves as the custodian of all Commission funds and monitors Commission's fiscal policies and procedures.

Since October 1, 2024, the Finance Committee has met nine times. During that time the committee created and regularly reviewed the budget for the commission.

Rules

It is the responsibility of the Rules Committee to develop uniform Compact rules, bylaw amendments, and policies for consideration by the Commission and concurrent implementation by the states; review existing rules and recommend necessary changes to the Commission for consideration; review existing rules and recommend necessary changes to the Commission for consideration; and draft frequently asked questions to clarify questions arising regarding statute, rules, bylaws, policies, and advisory opinions.

Since October 1, 2024, the Rules Committee has met eight times. During that time, the committee has drafted rules related to the compact privilege process and data system management.

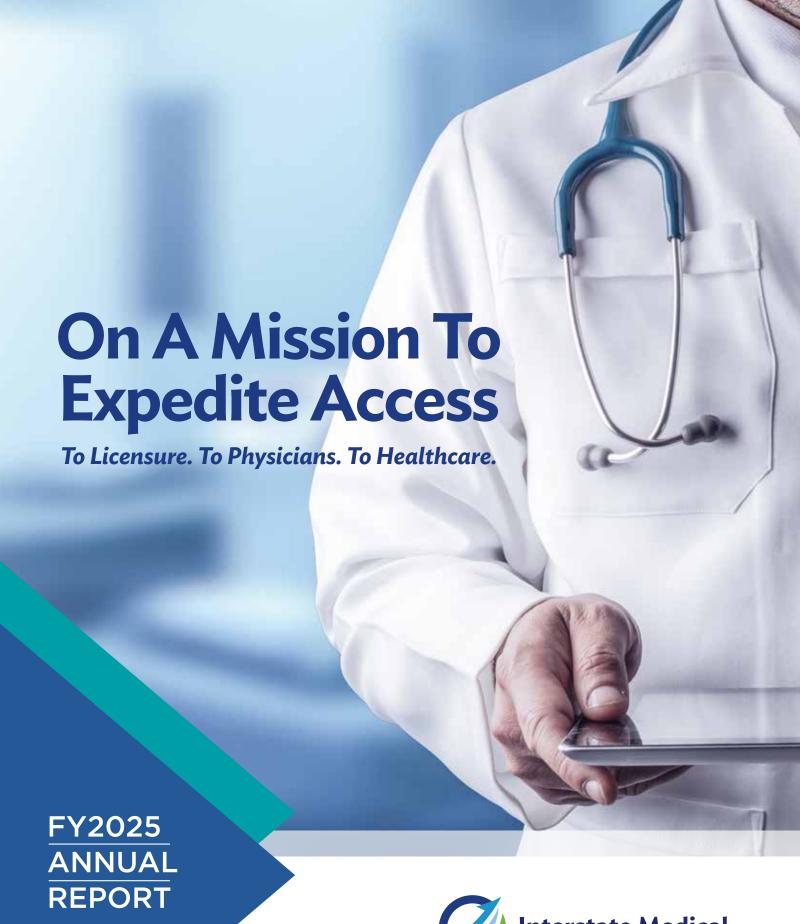

Two important terms used through-out this document:

- The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact, aka IMLC, represents the process and activities related to the organization in general as established in statute.
- The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission, aka IMLCC, represents the actions and activities of the compact's commissioners and staff.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITY

The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission (IMLCC) celebrated its 8th year of operations. There are over 49,000 physicians who use the IMLCC process to provide care and expand access in our member states. Approximately 54% of the physicians who obtain licenses through the IMLC process intend to use the license to provide services in rural or underserved areas; a significant milestone in our efforts to "Expediting Access to Licensure. To Physicians. And To Healthcare."

The IMLCC now has 44 member jurisdictions - 42 states, the Territory of Guam, and the District of Columbia. Arkansas and North Carolina are the most recent additions to the member jurisdiction count. We anticipate the introduction and/or consideration of legislation in at least 3 states during the 2026 state legislative sessions.

The Enhanced Physician Portal (EPP) is now in beta testing with an anticipated roll-out in early 2026. The start of the beta testing phase comes after a year of development which included input from physicians, member boards, and 3rd party users. The EPP is a "data wallet" that contains all the licenses obtained by a physician, and all the requirements established by the issuing boards to maintain that license - a benefit to the physician and the member board.

The Year 8 Data Study was published on July 3rd. The Data Study is an annual look at IMLCC processing information; average processing times, licenses obtained, etc. Included in the supplemental information are the number of Letters of Qualification (LOQs) and licenses issued by each member board. Some interesting highlights from the study:

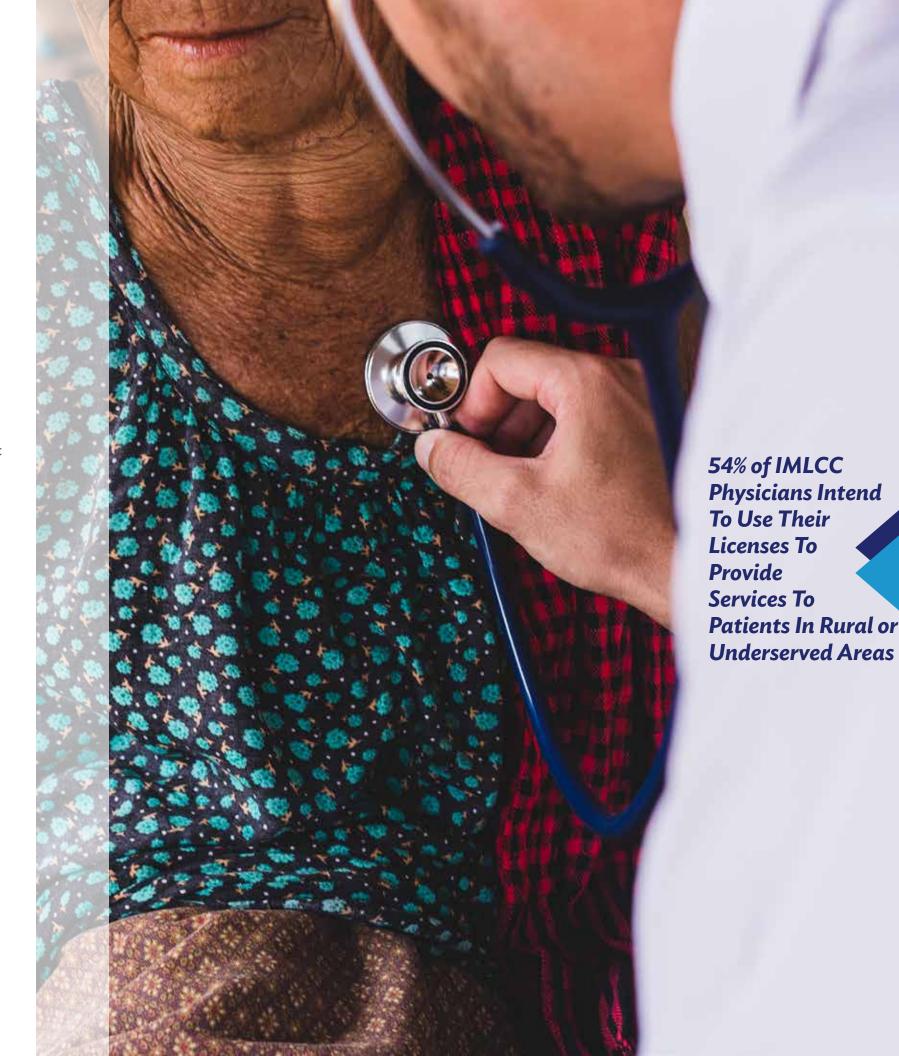
- 14% of physicians using the IMLC process obtain 7 or more licenses per application
- 52% of physicians obtain their LOQ in 30 days or less
- 51% of physicians receive all their requested licenses in 7 days or less
- 94.34% of Physicians reported that they strongly agree (69.47%) or agree (24.88%) with the question "Did you find the IMLC license process beneficial?"

These statistics show us just how much good work has been done by each of our member-board's licensing staff.

COMPLIANCE ACTIONS

There were a total of 83 disciplinary actions taken against the licenses held by 45 different physicians in FY2025. All impacted member boards were notified of the actions. Since 2017, there have been a total of 200 disciplinary actions taken against licenses held by 87 of the over 45,000 physicians who have used the Compact process.

A total of 31 Letters of Qualification (LOQ) were determined to be invalid by the State of Principal License after the LOQ had been issued. All impacted member boards were notified of the determinations. Since 2017, there have been 61 LOQs found to be invalid out of the 98,077 issued.

BUDGET REPORT

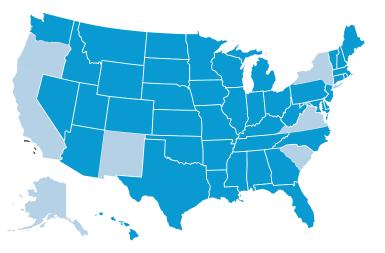

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

By every possible measure, IMLCC has demonstrated success in Fiscal Year 2025. Our member boards continue to process LOQ Applications in a timely and accurately fashion. Licenses are issued quickly so that physicians can begin practicing sooner, and the number of physicians using the IMLCC process continues to grow - now approaching 50,000.

Much of our effort this year has been about expanding access to the IMLCC process from withing our member-state licensure systems, with staff being invited to participate in the state Medical Staff Services association meetings. These meetings provided us an opportunity to talk directly with the state licensure staff that credential physicians and other healthcare professionals. Almost universally, they recognize the value that IMLCC brings to their organization and to their state.

I believe that EVERY U.S. State and Territory should become a member of IMLCC. Physicians benefit. Healthcare benefits. Citizens benefit. Toward that goal of 100% participation, significant time, effort and resources were spent this year on advocacy efforts - providing information and data to state and territorial legislatures so they better understand how to advocate for participation in IMLCC. We will continue this effort in the coming years until there are 50 member states and 5 member territories.

The launch of the Enhanced Physicians Portal (EPP) Beta Program was a key milestone in improving the tools and technology that support our Physicians and Member Boards. The EPP Beta program is expected to run for a couple of months and includes approximately 50 existing physician users, which we'll be closely monitoring once migrated.

The IMLCC team will be looking for feedback from our Beta users around bugs, usability improvements and any enhancements physician users may need in the future. The EPP will significantly change how physicians manage their licenses, and will directly impact the speed and accuracy of our member boards' application processing.

Finally, two notable statistics from our recently published data reports:

• 18% of Physicians using the IMLCC System Apply for 7 or More Licenses.

The IMLCC can't create more physicians. But our data technology makes it much easier for physicians to become licensed in multiple states - providing greater access to a larger number of patients. • Almost 40% of all new physician licenses are issued through the IMLCC process. Across the 42 member states, DC and Guam, 37.41% of all new physician licenses issued in the calendar year 2024 were through the IMLCC. 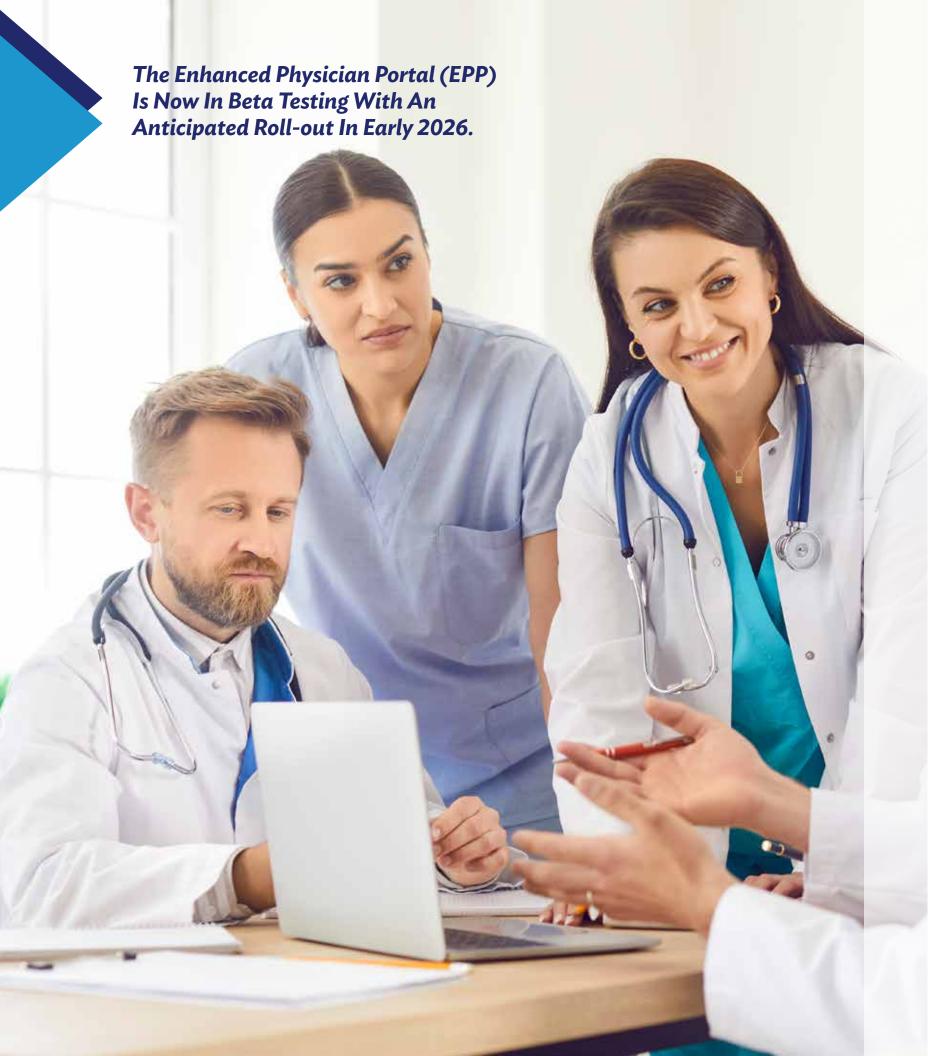

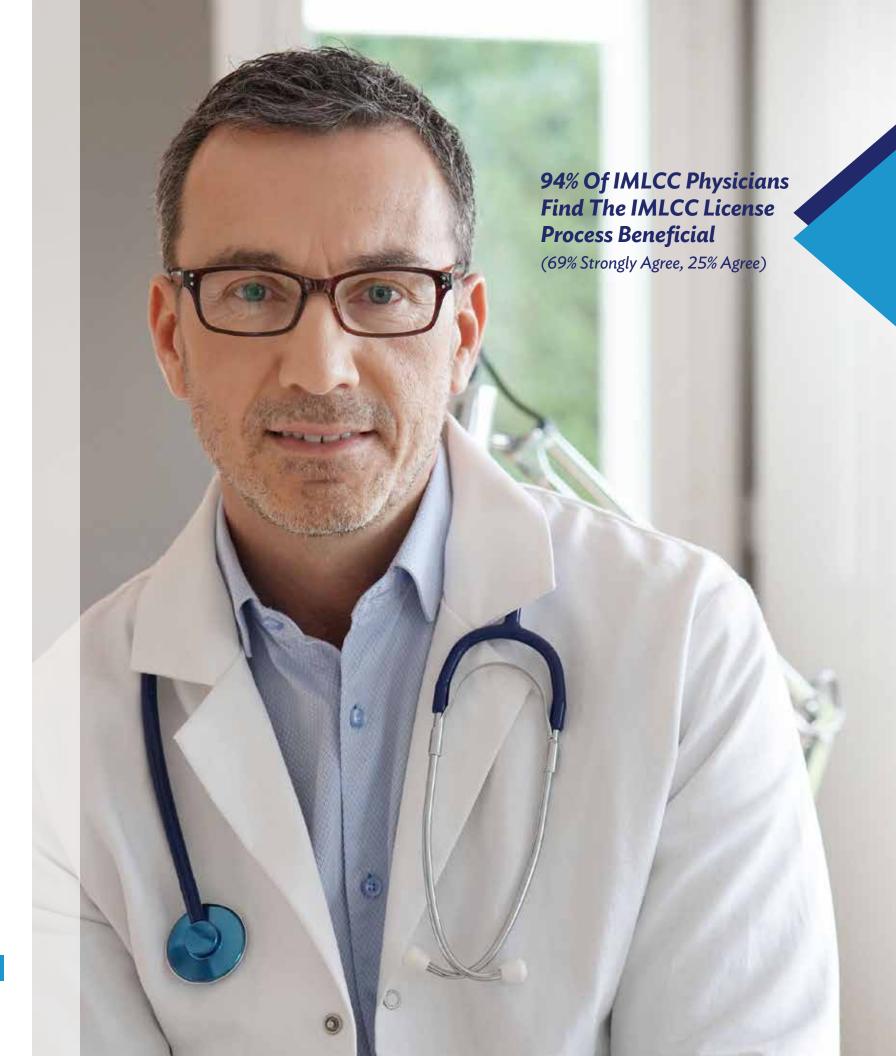

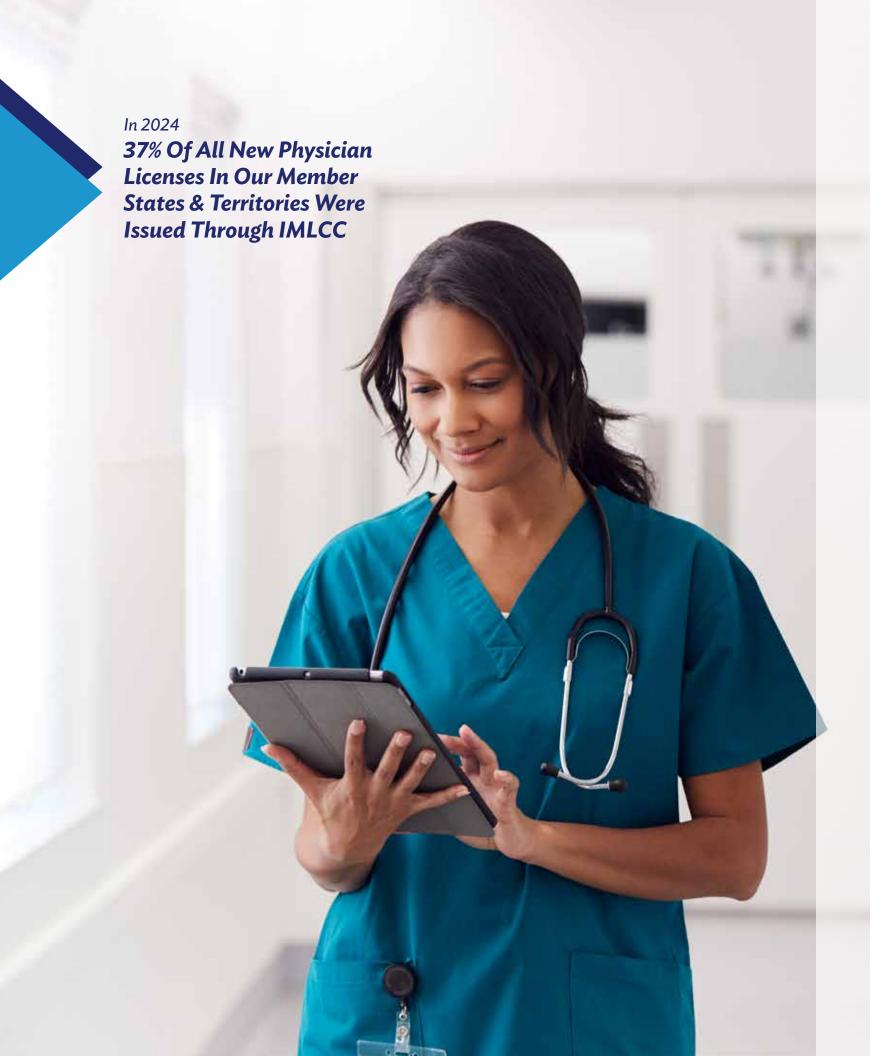

AGREEMENT FOR CORRECTIVE ACTION

This Agreement for Corrective Action ("Agreement") is entered into by and between Juliette Emily Petersen, M.D. ("Respondent") and the Complaint Review Committee of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice ("Committee") pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statutes section 214.103, subdivision 6(a) (2024). Respondent was represented by John Casserly, Geraghty O'Loughlin & Kenney, P.A., Wells Fargo Place, Suite 2750, 30 East Seventh Street, Saint Paul, Minneapolis, 55101. The Committee was represented by Daniel Schueppert, Assistant Attorney General, 445 Minnesota Street, Suite 600, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101. Respondent and the Committee hereby agree as follows:

FACTS

- 1. For the purpose of this Agreement, the Board may consider the following facts as true:
- a. Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota on March 6, 2004. Respondent is board certified in psychiatry.
- b. In August 2024, the Board received a report that a medical malpractice settlement payment was made on behalf of Respondent for her care of a patient ("Patient #1") who was experiencing a mental health crisis with suicidal ideation.

- c. Respondent provided psychiatric care to Patient #1 intermittently from 2018 through early 2021. On January 25, 2021, Patient #1 and Respondent spoke via telephone, although Respondent was not scheduled to work at the time. Although Patient #1 experienced suicidal thoughts, Respondent believed the suicidal ideation was decreasing, referred Patient #1 to a more intensive therapy program where Patient #1 had previously received care, confirmed plans for an appointment in two days, and increased Patient #1's medication.
- d. Patient #1 cancelled their appointment with Respondent, and Respondent did not follow-up with Patient #1. On February 1, 2021, Respondent was notified that Patient #1 died by suicide. On that same day, Respondent placed a note in Patient #1's medical record documenting her conversation with Patient #1 on January 25, 2021. The note stated that Patient #1 had been having "some suicidal thoughts with some intent and plan," but those thoughts had decreased.
- e. On June 2, 2025, Respondent appeared before the Committee to discuss the allegations. During the conference, Respondent admitted she did not have access to Patient #1's medical records when she spoke with Patient #1 on the phone in January 2021 and she jotted down some notes but forgot to chart them until after Patient #1's death.
- 2. Based on the discussion, the Committee views Respondent's conduct as inappropriate under Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1 (g) (engaging in any unethical or improper conduct), (k) (engaging in conduct that departs from or fails to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing medical practice), (o) (improper management of medical records, including failure to maintain adequate medical records), and (s) inappropriate prescribing of or failure to properly prescribe a drug or device) (2024), and Respondent agrees that

the conduct cited above constitutes a reasonable basis in law and fact to justify corrective action under these statutes.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

- 3. Respondent agrees to address the concerns referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 by taking the following corrective action:
- a. Within six months of the date of the Agreement, Respondent shall successfully complete a pre-approved course in:
 - i. Assessment of Patients in Mental Health Crisis; and
 - ii. Medical Record Management and Documentation.
- b. Within three months of successful completion of the above-referenced coursework, she shall write and submit a paper, for review and approval by the Committee, discussing what she has learned from the coursework and describe what changes she could have made with respect to handling her care of Patient #1; and
- c. This Agreement shall be satisfied upon Respondent's successful completion of the terms of the Agreement.
- 4. This Agreement shall become effective upon execution by the Committee and shall remain in effect until Respondent successfully completes the terms of the Agreement. Successful completion shall be determined by the Committee. Upon Respondent's signature and the Committee's execution of this Agreement, the Committee agrees to close the complaints resulting in the information referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2. Respondent understands and further agrees that if, after the matter has been closed, the Committee receives additional complaints similar to the information in paragraphs 1 and 2, the Committee may reopen the closed complaint.

The Committee was represented by Carlos Figari, Assistant Attorney General, 445 Minnesota Street, Suite 600, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101. Respondent and the Committee hereby agree as follows:

FACTS

- 1. For the purpose of this Agreement, the Board may consider the following facts as true:
- a. Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota on November 21, 2023.
- b. In July 2024, Respondent self-reported a malpractice settlement regard the care of a pregnant patient (Patient #1) who presented with nausea and vomiting, experienced fetal demise at 27 weeks gestation, and was later diagnosed with diabetic ketoacidosis. In her written

response to the Board's inquiry, Respondent stated that hospital staff failed to notify Respondent of Patient #1's concerning glucose levels, abnormal vital signs, or decreased fetal movement.

- c. On June 2, 2025, Respondent appeared before the Committee to discuss the allegations. Respondent acknowledged that she did not screen Patient #1 for diabetes early in pregnancy other than ordering a glucose challenge test between 24 and 28 weeks of pregnancy, even though Patient #1 was high risk for diabetes and met criteria to undergo targeted early pregnancy screening. Respondent admitted medical decisions are her responsibility and holds hospital staff responsible for failing to provide accurate medical information about Patient #1.
- 2. Based on the discussion, the Committee views Respondent's conduct as inappropriate under Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1 (g) (engaging in unethical or improper conduct) and (k) (engaging in conduct that departs from or fails to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing medical practice in which case proof of actual injury need not be established) (2024). Respondent agrees that the conduct cited above constitutes a reasonable basis in law and fact to justify corrective action under these statutes.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

- 3. Respondent agrees to address the concerns referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 by taking the following corrective action:
- a. Within nine months of the date of the Agreement, Respondent shall successfully complete pre-approved courses in:
 - i. Team communication and
 - ii. Managing early glucose screening during pregnancy.
- b. Within three months of successful completion of the above-referenced coursework, Respondent shall write and submit a paper, for review and approval by the

- a. Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota on February 24, 2022. Respondent is board certified family medicine.
- b. In September 2024, the Board received a report that the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners ("LA Board") issued a Consent Order for Reprimand ("LA Consent Order") upon receiving information that Respondent violated the Federal False Claims Act by ordering medically unnecessary genetic testing for Medicare beneficiaries residing

in Delaware and that Respondent agreed to pay \$500,000 to the federal government to resolve the allegations. The LA Consent Order included a reprimand, a fine, and a requirement that Respondent complete continuing medical education for fraudulent billing practices.

- c. In November 2024, the Board received a report that the Tennessee Board of Medical Examiners reprimanded Respondent and assessed a civil penalty based on the disciplinary action taken by the LA Board.
