**ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL
LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Psychology (“Board”) convened on November 18, 2011, to review the removal of the conditions placed on the license of Ronald L. Odden, M.S., L.P. (LP 0303) by Stipulation And Consent Order signed on May 13, 2011 (“May, 2011 Order”). The May, 2011 Order placed practice restrictions on his license to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota. Having considered the Complaint Resolution Committee’s (“Committee”) recommendation that Licensee be granted an unconditional license, the Board determines that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled all requirements and conditions set forth in the May, 2011 Order as follows:

1. Pursuant to paragraph 4a., within (thirty) 30 days of the date of the signed Stipulation and Consent Order licensee shall arrange to enroll in an individualized professional boundaries training course. Licensee shall complete the course within twelve (12) months of the date of the signed Stipulation and Consent Order.
2. Pursuant to paragraph 4b., within (thirty) 30 days of completing the professional boundaries course licensee shall submit a report to the Committee.
3. Pursuant to paragraph 4c., within (sixty) 60 days of completing the professional boundaries course licensee shall cause the instructor of the professional boundaries course to submit a report to the Committee.
4. Pursuant to paragraph 4d., within in (sixty) 60 days of the date of the signed Stipulation and Consent Order licensee shall pay a civil penalty to the Board in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).

The committee received documentation verifying licensee’s compliance with the remedies listed in paragraphs 4a – 4d and all subsequence paragraphs of the May 2011 Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

ORDER

Licensee shall be granted an UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.

The May, 2011 Order is superseded by this Order of Unconditional License and shall have no future force or effect.
