**ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Veterinary Medicine (“Board”) Complaint Review Committee has reviewed the petition of Wayne D. Scanlan, D.V.M. (“Licensee”), for reinstatement of an unconditional license to practice veterinary medicine and makes the following:

BACKGROUND

1. Licensee and the Complaint Review Committee (“Committee”) entered into a Stipulation and Order approved by the Board on February 6, 2013 (“2013 Order”), placing a limitation on Licensee’s license to practice veterinary medicine. The 2013 Order was based on evidence that Licensee violated Minnesota Statutes section 156.081, subdivision 2(12), and Minnesota Rules 9100.0700 and 9100.0800.

2. Pursuant to section III, paragraph 4, of the 2013 Order:

a. During the course of a dog’s tooth extraction, Licensee failed to remove the entire tooth, and numerous tooth remnants remaining in the dog’s mouth became infected and resulted in continued pain.

b. As part of the Board’s investigation, the Committee reviewed Licensee’s medical records for the dog. The Committee determined the records revealed numerous areas of substandard record keeping, including missing documentation.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board makes the following findings of fact:

3. Pursuant to section V, paragraph 6, of the 2013 Order, the limitation placed on Licensee's license prohibited the practice of veterinary dentistry in the State of Minnesota until Licensee complied with the following requirements pertaining to:

- a. Continuing Education in Companion Animal Dentistry.
- b. Additional Continuing Education.
- c. Observation by Board-Certified Consultant.
- d. Compliance With Consultant's Recommendations.
- e. Written Protocols.
- f. Continuing Education Audit.
- g. Records Inspection.
- h. Compliance With Record Keeping Laws.
- i. Failure to Obtain Committee Approval.

The Board has received notification that Licensee has completed all requirements.


Based on the foregoing, the Board, having reviewed Licensee's petition for reinstatement of an unconditional license to practice veterinary medicine and having concluded that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled the 2013 Order issued by the Board on February 6, 2013, hereby issues the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Licensee, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
