**ORDER OF  
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Physical Therapy ("Board"), having convened on September 19, 2013, to review the petition of BeVan Presley, P.T. ("Petitioner"), for an unconditional license as a physical therapist in the State of Minnesota, makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On July 19, 2012, the Board approved a Stipulation and Order ("2012 Order") conditioning and limiting Petitioner's license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota.
2. The 2012 Order limited Petitioner to practicing in group settings and required him to complete a 12-hour individualized boundaries course in addition to requirements previously imposed by a 2007 Stipulation and Order ("2007 Order"). The 2007 Order consisted of the following: (1) the Essentials for Physical Therapy Practice course; (2) an 80-hour individualized geriatric/amputee training program; and (3) on-site work evaluations by Minnesota Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association Peer Review.
3. The Board has reviewed and considered Petitioner's petition and determined that Petitioner has satisfied the terms of the 2007 and 2012 Orders.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

**ORDER**

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all previous orders, including the 2007 and 2012 Orders, are **RESCINDED** and shall have no future force or effect.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Petitioner, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
