

Opiate Product Registration Fee Submitting Data

Submit a Transaction Report:

- Facilities that sold, delivered, or distributed any opiate within or into the State of Minnesota during the previous calendar year, the qualifying transaction data must be submitted to the Board of Pharmacy, in ARCOS format, by March 1st of each year.

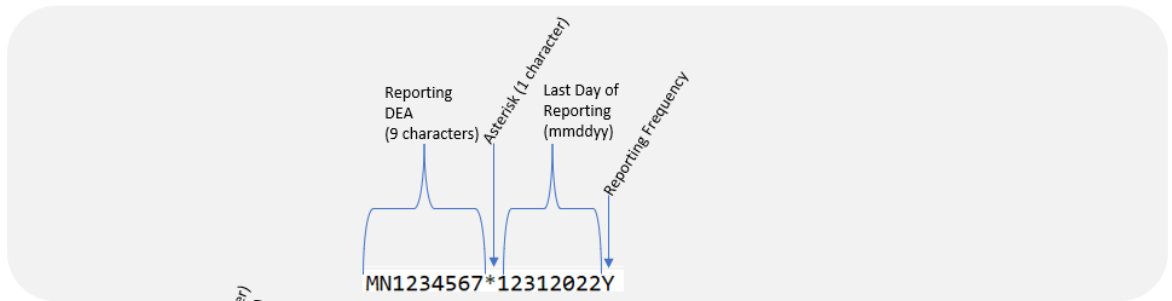

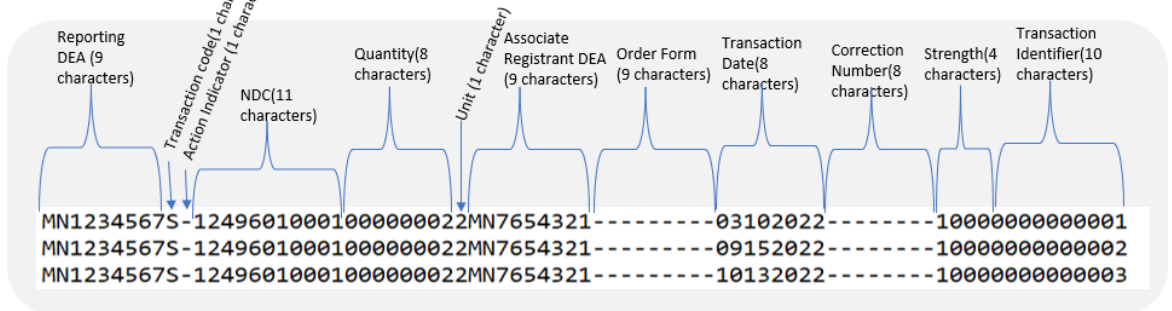

Required File Format: .dat or .txt

Facilities **registered with the FDA as an outsourcing facility:**

- The facility must report opiate distributions to the Board as defined by Minnesota Statute [§151.066](#).

If a **3PL is reporting opiate distributions to the Board**, it is critical that the manufacturer or wholesaler, as well as the Board, be notified of the reporting. This is to prevent duplicative reporting by both the 3PL and manufacture or wholesaler.
