ORDER FOR REINSTATEMENT

1. The Minnesota Board of Psychology (“Board”) is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 148.88 through 148.98 to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, petition, or hold licenses to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 214.10 and 214.103 to review complaints against psychologists, to refer such complaints to the Attorney General’s Office, and to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Joel A. Schirvar, Psy.D., LP (“Licensee”) has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a license to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 214.101, the license of a psychologist must be suspended if the Board receives an order from a court or a child support magistrate or a notice from a public authority responsible for child support enforcement that the licensee is in arrears in child support or maintenance payments.

4. On April 21, 2011, the Board received a Notice to Suspend Occupational or Professional License(s) from the Washington County Community Services Child Support Unit, which advised the Board that Licensee was not in compliance with a court

order for child support, and under Minn. Stat. §§ 318A.66, the Board must suspend Licensee's license to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota.

5. On May 20, 2011, the Board issued an Order for Suspension and served it on Licensee, as required by Minn. Stat. §§ 214.101, Subdivison. 1.


6. On February 29, 2012 the Board received notification from the Washington County Community Services Child Support Unit that Licensee has complied with the court order, or payment agreement for child support and/or maintenance payments and his license can be reinstated.

ORDER

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Licensee's license to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota shall be and is **REINSTATED**, effective February 29, 2012.
