Agenda Item 3: Presentation by the Health Professionals Services Program

Agenda Item 5: May 20, 2026, Policy & Planning Committee Report & Motions

Dr. Arko, Chair of the Policy & Planning Committee ("Committee"), presented the Committee's report from its May 20, 2026, meeting and the two motions from that meeting.

Motion #1 - Changes to Attestation Questions

Approve the proposed changes to the attestation questions #1 and #2 as asked on applications at time of initial licensure or registration.

After discussion, including the request for a legal review, a motion was proposed to table the initial licensure application questions a second to the motion was offered and the motion was passed with unanimous consent.

Dr. Arko presented the proposed changes questions #1 and #2 on the annual renewal applications.

A motion to adopt the changes to questions #1 and #2 on asked on the annual renewal was made, a second to the motion was offered and the motion was passed with unanimous consent.

Motion #2 - Verification of Postgraduate Medical Training Form

A motion passed requesting that the full Board discuss adding a time frame to the Verification of Postgraduate Medical Training form used for physicians applying for initial licensure.

It was noted the question under consideration for modification is: "Did the individual take a leave of absence or break during training?"

The Board discussed the ambiguity of what is considered a "break" and discussion further explored if the question needs to be asked at all.

A motion to remove the question in its entirety was made, a second to the motion was offered and the motion was passed with unanimous consent.

Dr. Arko concluded the Committee report.

Agenda Item 6: May 12, 2026, Health Professionals Services Program, Program Committee Report

Ms. Huntley presented the Program Committee Report and noted that the materials from the meeting were included in the agenda.

VI. **HPSP Updates** – The HPSP team remains steady with a staff of 10, managing a significant and complex caseload. On average, each case manager oversees approximately 80 individuals, with roughly 550 participants active in the program at any given time. Of these, about 75 individuals are in the determination phase, while more than 400 are progressing under Participation Agreements. Approximately 30% of all referrals received do not result in monitoring, reflecting both the diversity of referral reasons and HPSP’s careful criteria for determining eligibility.

VII. **Presentation: HPSP – Case Manager Review**

The HPSP Staff Members (Nicky Williams, Andrew Leinen, Johanna Gangl, Pang Yang, and Tracy Erfourth) reviewed and discussed two fictional case scenarios illustrating the processes and decision-making practices of the Health Professionals Services Program (HPSP). Case managers highlighted their current and past roles, their values and how they align with HPSP’s [Value Statements](#) (Integrity, Respect, Informed, Accountability, Excellence), and our monitoring approach, emphasizing patient safety, strong collaboration with treating providers, and individualized participant support.

Objectives Covered

- Understanding HPSP’s referral pathways, monitoring structure, and clinical decision-making.
- Applying HPSP procedures through real-world scenarios.
- Highlighting the complexities faced by participants referred for medical, mental health, or substance use concerns.

Case Scenario A: Medical Condition (TBI) A self referred participant reported cognitive challenges following a head injury. HPSP requested a neuropsychological evaluation and a temporary refrain from practice. Evaluation revealed executive function deficits, leading to an 18-month Participation Agreement with occupational therapy, neurology follow-up, and ongoing assessments. Despite limited improvement and eventual job loss due to extended

leave, providers felt the participant could safely manage their condition independently. HPSP determined successful completion with recommendation to continue treatment.

Case Scenario B: Substance Use & Mental Health A therapist submitted a confidential third-party referral regarding substance use involving alcohol, cannabis, and Kratom. Assessment confirmed multiple substance use disorders and recommended intensive outpatient treatment, abstinence, therapy, and support group engagement. A 36-month Participation Agreement was established.

The participant initially struggled with compliance, prompting an initial report to the licensing board. Later concerns—including missed appointments, diluted toxicology results, and a positive PEth and Kratom screen—resulted in further investigation through a Toxicology Director Opinion. Findings showed levels inconsistent with incidental exposure, and due to continued denial despite evidence, the participant was unsuccessfully discharged.

General Themes Discussed

- Importance of clinical data and provider recommendations in decision-making.
- Workflow for weekly team case consultations.
- Reporting requirements, statutory obligations, and when non-compliance necessitates board notification.
- Assessing insight, practice safety, and readiness for completion or discharge.

Questions from Committee Members:

Q: How do you determine end date for Participation Agreements when it is something like a TBI, a life changing diagnosis in which progress and the future are so unknown?

A: For conditions like traumatic brain injury where recovery is unpredictable, HPSP sets a Participation Agreement end date based on provider recommendations and the minimum time needed to evaluate stability. The end date doesn't imply full recovery—it marks a point to assess whether the participant can safely self-manage their condition.

*If the participant is stable, follows treatment, and shows insight into their limitations, HPSP may close the case. Because these conditions can change over time, the participant is instructed to contact HPSP **before returning to practice** so monitoring can resume if needed.*

In essence, HPSP is not monitoring to resolve the illness—we are monitoring whether the participant can manage their condition in a way that protects the public.

Q: In these cases, would you ask the providers to refer the Licensee back to the program when they have approved the licensee's return to practice?

A: In situations like this, we may ask providers to refer the licensee back to HPSP when they approve a return to practice—but it isn't automatic. Each provider sees HPSP through their own professional lens, and their comfort level with monitoring varies. Ideally, we want them to notify us, and it's often a conversation we initiate when we see that a participant's condition may require future oversight. Ultimately, the goal is to ensure a smooth handoff and maintain public safety, while recognizing that provider engagement can differ case by case.

Q: What about cognitive decline due to aging? How do you determine monitoring needs?

A: When a licensee's cognitive decline progresses from mild to moderate or severe, HPSP cannot continue monitoring. Our program is designed to support individuals who can still safely manage their condition with guidance, which typically aligns only with mild impairment. Once a treating provider determines the condition has advanced beyond mild, the licensee is no longer eligible for monitoring, and the case is discharged unsuccessfully to the board.

At that point, the provider's evaluation usually states that the licensee is unable to practice safely. This clinical determination is what triggers the report—not HPSP deciding the severity itself. Our role remains focused on monitoring only when an illness can be safely self managed with oversight; when it cannot, responsibility shifts to the board for further action.

Q: What about if a licensee is referred to HPSP but does not cooperate and provide you the medical documents or assessments you need?

A: When a licensee is referred to HPSP but does not cooperate—meaning they decline evaluations, do not return authorizations, or otherwise prevent HPSP from assessing their condition—we cannot determine eligibility for monitoring. Because our decisions rely heavily on treatment provider evaluations and recommendations, lack of cooperation leaves us without the clinical information needed to establish safety.

In these situations, HPSP must discharge the case to the licensing board. This is not a determination of illness severity—it is simply the result of being unable to complete an

assessment. Without provider input, HPSP cannot ensure public safety through monitoring, and the board becomes responsible for next steps.

After discussion of the motion, a request for a legal review was made to consider if the changes would impact the Board's ability to enter into disciplinary action with an applicant.

The Committee received an opinion that from a legal perspective the proposed changes to questions #1 and #2 on initial application would not impact the Board's ability to take disciplinary action under [section 147.091](#). The Committee met again on September 3, 2026, and brings the following motion:

Motion #1:

Adopt the following changes to the attestation questions asked on applications at time of initial licensure or registration:

A: Proposed revisions to **initial** application attestation questions #1 and 2 as follows:

Question #1: Do you currently have any condition that is not being appropriately treated ~~which is likely to~~ **that** impairs or adversely affects your ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety in a competent, ethical, and professional manner? If yes, please describe.

Question #2: Does your use of alcohol or chemical substance(s), including prescription medications, ~~in any way that~~ **currently** impair or limit your ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety? If yes, please describe.

The mission of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice is to protect the public's health and safety by assuring that the people who practice medicine or as an allied health professional are competent, ethical practitioners with the necessary knowledge and skills appropriate to their title and role.

The Board's Policy and Planning Committee ("Committee") met on May 20, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. via Webex.

1. Call to Order

The meeting of the Policy and Planning Committee ("Committee") was called to order at 11:00 a.m.

2. Adoption of the Agenda

A motion was made and seconded to approve the agenda for the May 20, 2026, Committee meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Approval of Minutes

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the December 22, 2025, Policy and Planning Committee meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Selection of Committee Chair

Dr. Arko expressed interest in serving as Chair of the Policy and Planning Committee and formally submitted his name for consideration. No other members expressed interest in this position. A motion to elect Dr. Arko as Chair was made and seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Presentation: Dr. Lorna Breen Heroes' Foundation and American Medical Association

Presenters:

- Shari Purpura, Paralegal, Dr. Lorna Breen Heroes' Foundation
- Daniel Blaney-Koen, J.D., Senior Attorney, AMA Advocacy Resource Center

Ms. Purpura and Mr. Blaney-Koen provided an overview of the "Well Being First, MN" initiative from the AMA's perspective. They noted that Minnesota is considered a national leader in promoting physician and healthcare provider well-being, and that Minnesota's 2021 efforts helped catalyze the AMA's national campaign. The presenters described the AMA's request to remove attestation language requiring disclosure, or the possibility of disclosure, when no

current impairment exists. They emphasized the need to balance public safety with ensuring that healthcare professionals are able to seek care without unnecessary barriers.

A motion was made and seconded to move forward with the proposed changes. After discussion, a friendly amendment was offered to request that the Board adopt:

- the proposed revisions to initial application attestation questions 1 and 2;
- the corresponding changes to renewal application attestation questions 1 and 2; and
- the proposed revisions to question 3, including adding the definition of “currently,” as outlined in the agenda materials.

The amended motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

A second motion was made and seconded to request that the full Board discuss adding a time frame to the Verification of Postgraduate Medical Training form used for physicians applying for initial licensure. The motion passed unanimously.

6. Other Business

No additional business was brought before the Committee.

7. Adjournment

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.

Initial Application Attestation Questions

Question 1: “Do you currently have any condition that is not being appropriately treated which is likely to impair or adversely affect your ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety in a competent, ethical, and professional manner? If yes, please describe.”

147.091 GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

Subdivision 1. **Grounds listed.** The board may refuse to grant a license, may refuse to grant registration to perform interstate telehealth services, or may impose disciplinary action as described in section 147.141 against any physician. The following conduct is prohibited and is grounds for disciplinary action:

(a) Failure to demonstrate the qualifications or satisfy the requirements for a license contained in this chapter or rules of the board. The burden of proof shall be upon the applicant to demonstrate such qualifications or satisfaction of such requirements.

(b) Obtaining a license by fraud or cheating, or attempting to subvert the licensing examination process. Conduct which subverts or attempts to subvert the licensing examination process includes, but is not limited to: (1) conduct which violates the security of the examination materials, such as removing examination materials from the examination room or having unauthorized possession of any portion of a future, current, or previously administered licensing examination; (2) conduct which violates the standard of test administration, such as communicating with another examinee during administration of the examination, copying another examinee's answers, permitting another examinee to copy one's answers, or possessing unauthorized materials; or (3) impersonating an examinee or permitting an impersonator to take the examination on one's own behalf.

(c) Conviction, during the previous five years, of a felony reasonably related to the practice of medicine or osteopathic medicine. Conviction as used in this subdivision shall include a conviction of an offense which if committed in this state would be deemed a felony without regard to its designation elsewhere, or a criminal proceeding where a finding or verdict of guilt is made or returned but the adjudication of guilt is either withheld or not entered thereon.

(d) Revocation, suspension, restriction, limitation, or other disciplinary action against the person's medical license in another state or jurisdiction, failure to report to the board that charges regarding the person's license have been brought in another state or jurisdiction, or having been refused a license by any other state or jurisdiction.

(e) Advertising which is false or misleading, which violates any rule of the board, or which claims without substantiation the positive cure of any disease, or professional superiority to or greater skill than that possessed by another physician.

(f) Violating a rule promulgated by the board or an order of the board, a state, or federal law which relates to the practice of medicine, or in part regulates the practice of medicine including without limitation sections 604.201, 609.344, and 609.345, or a state or federal narcotics or controlled substance law.

(g) Engaging in any unethical or improper conduct, including but not limited to:

(1) conduct likely to deceive or defraud the public;

(2) conduct likely to harm the public;

(3) conduct that demonstrates a willful or careless disregard for the health, welfare, or safety of a patient;

(4) medical practice that is professionally incompetent; and

(5) conduct that may create unnecessary danger to any patient's life, health, or safety, in any of which cases, proof of actual injury need not be established.

(h) Failure to provide proper supervision, including but not limited to supervision of a:

- (1) licensed or unlicensed health care provider; and
- (2) physician under any agreement with the board.

(i) Aiding or abetting an unlicensed person in the practice of medicine, except that it is not a violation of this paragraph for a physician to employ, supervise, or delegate functions to a qualified person who may or may not be required to obtain a license or registration to provide health services if that person is practicing within the scope of that person's license or registration or delegated authority.

(j) Adjudication by a court of competent jurisdiction, within or outside this state, as:

- (1) mentally incompetent;
- (2) mentally ill;
- (3) developmentally disabled;
- (4) a chemically dependent person;
- (5) a person dangerous to the public;
- (6) a sexually dangerous person; or
- (7) a person who has a sexual psychopathic personality.

Such adjudication shall automatically suspend a license for the duration of the adjudication unless the board orders otherwise.

(k) Conduct that departs from or fails to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing medical practice in which case proof of actual injury need not be established.

(l) Inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of the following, including but not limited to:

- (1) illness;
- (2) intoxication;
- (3) use of drugs, narcotics, chemicals, or any other type of substance;
- (4) mental condition;
- (5) physical condition;
- (6) diminished cognitive ability;
- (7) loss of motor skills; or
- (8) deterioration through the aging process.

(m) Revealing a privileged communication from or relating to a patient except when otherwise required or permitted by law.

(n) Failure by a doctor of osteopathic medicine to identify the school of healing in the professional use of the doctor's name by one of the following terms: osteopathic physician and surgeon, doctor of osteopathic medicine, or D.O.

(o) Improper management of medical records, including failure to maintain adequate medical records, to comply with a patient's request made pursuant to sections 144.291 to 144.298, or to furnish a medical record or report required by law.

(p) Fee splitting, including without limitation:

(1) paying, offering to pay, receiving, or agreeing to receive, a commission, rebate, or remuneration, directly or indirectly, primarily for the referral of patients or the prescription of drugs or devices;

(2) dividing fees with another physician or a professional corporation, unless the division is in proportion to the services provided and the responsibility assumed by each professional and the physician has disclosed the terms of the division;

(3) referring a patient to any health care provider as defined in sections 144.291 to 144.298 in which the referring physician has a "financial or economic interest," as defined in section 144.6521, subdivision 3, unless the physician has disclosed the physician's financial or economic interest in accordance with section 144.6521; and

(4) dispensing for profit any drug or device, unless the physician has disclosed the physician's own profit interest.

The physician must make the disclosures required in this clause in advance and in writing to the patient and must include in the disclosure a statement that the patient is free to choose a different health care provider. This clause does not apply to the distribution of revenues from a partnership, group practice, nonprofit corporation, or professional corporation to its partners, shareholders, members, or employees if the revenues consist only of fees for services performed by the physician or under a physician's direct supervision, or to the division or distribution of prepaid or capitated health care premiums, or fee-for-service withhold amounts paid under contracts established under other state law.

(q) Engaging in abusive or fraudulent billing practices, including violations of the federal Medicare and Medicaid laws or state medical assistance laws.

(r) Becoming addicted or habituated to a drug or intoxicant.

(s) Inappropriate prescribing of or failure to properly prescribe a drug or device, including prescribing a drug or device for other than medically accepted therapeutic or experimental or investigative purposes authorized by a state or federal agency.

(t) Engaging in conduct with a patient which is sexual or may reasonably be interpreted by the patient as sexual, or in any verbal behavior which is seductive or sexually demeaning to a patient.

(u) Failure to make reports as required by section 147.111 or to cooperate with an investigation of the board as required by section 147.131.

(v) Knowingly providing false or misleading information that is directly related to the care of that patient unless done for an accepted therapeutic purpose such as the administration of a placebo.

(w) Aiding suicide or aiding attempted suicide in violation of section 609.215 as established by any of the following:

(1) a copy of the record of criminal conviction or plea of guilty for a felony in violation of section 609.215, subdivision 1 or 2;

(2) a copy of the record of a judgment of contempt of court for violating an injunction issued under section 609.215, subdivision 4;

(3) a copy of the record of a judgment assessing damages under section 609.215, subdivision 5; or

(4) a finding by the board that the person violated section 609.215, subdivision 1 or 2. The board shall investigate any complaint of a violation of section 609.215, subdivision 1 or 2.

(x) Practice of a board-regulated profession under lapsed or nonrenewed credentials.

(y) Failure to repay a state or federally secured student loan in accordance with the provisions of the loan.

(z) Providing interstate telehealth services other than according to section 147.032.

Subd. 1a. **Conviction of a felony-level criminal sexual conduct offense.** (a) The board may not grant a license to practice medicine to any person who has been convicted of a felony-level criminal sexual conduct offense.

(b) A license to practice medicine is automatically revoked if the licensee is convicted of a felony-level criminal sexual conduct offense.

(c) A license that has been denied or revoked pursuant to this subdivision is not subject to chapter 364.

(d) For purposes of this subdivision, "conviction" means a plea of guilty, a verdict of guilty by a jury, or a finding of guilty by the court, and "criminal sexual conduct offense" means a violation of sections 609.342 to 609.345 or a similar statute in another jurisdiction.

Subd. 1b. **Utilization review.** The board may investigate allegations and impose disciplinary action as described in section 147.141 against a physician performing utilization review for a pattern of failure to exercise that degree of care that a physician reviewer of ordinary prudence making utilization review determinations for a utilization review organization would use under the same or similar circumstances. As part of its investigative process, the board shall receive consultation or recommendation from physicians who are currently engaged in utilization review activities. The internal and external review processes under sections 62M.06 and 62Q.73 must be exhausted prior to an allegation being brought under this subdivision. Nothing in this subdivision creates, modifies, or changes existing law related to tort liability for medical negligence. Nothing in this subdivision preempts state peer review law protection in accordance with sections 145.61 to 145.67, federal peer review law, or current law pertaining to complaints or appeals.

Subd. 1c. **Reproductive health care services.** (a) For purposes of this subdivision, "reproductive health care services" means medical, surgical, counseling, or referral services relating to the human reproductive system, including but not limited to services related to pregnancy, contraception, or the termination of a pregnancy.

(b) Notwithstanding subdivision 1, paragraph (c) or (d), the board shall not refuse to grant a license to an applicant for licensure, refuse to grant registration to a physician to perform interstate telehealth services, or impose disciplinary action against a physician solely on one or more of the following grounds:

(1) the applicant or physician provided or assisted in the provision of reproductive health care services in a manner that is lawful in this state and that is within the applicable scope of practice;

(2) the applicant or physician was convicted in another jurisdiction of a felony resulting from conduct specified in clause (1); or

(3) the applicant or physician was subject to disciplinary action in another jurisdiction or was refused a license to practice medicine in another jurisdiction resulting from conduct specified in clause (1).

Subd. 2. Automatic suspension; suspension for failure to maintain name and address; name and address currency. (a) A license to practice medicine is automatically suspended if (1) a guardian of a licensee is appointed by order of a court pursuant to sections 524.5-101 to 524.5-502, for reasons other than the minority of the licensee; or (2) the licensee is committed by order of a court pursuant to chapter 253B. The license remains suspended until the licensee is restored to capacity by a court and, upon petition by the licensee, the suspension is terminated by the board after a hearing.

(b) Upon notice to the board of a judgment of, or a plea of guilty to, a felony reasonably related to the practice of patient care, the credentials of the regulated person shall be automatically suspended by the board. The credentials shall remain suspended until, upon petition by the regulated person and after a hearing, the suspension is terminated by the board. The board shall indefinitely suspend or revoke the credentials of the regulated person if, after a hearing, the board finds that the felonious conduct would cause a serious risk of harm to the public.

(c) For credentials that have been suspended or revoked pursuant to paragraphs (a) and (b), the regulated person may be reinstated to practice, either with or without restrictions, by demonstrating clear and convincing evidence of rehabilitation, as provided in section 364.03. If the regulated person's conviction is subsequently overturned by court decision, the board shall conduct a hearing to review the suspension within 30 days after receipt of the court decision. The regulated person is not required to prove rehabilitation if the subsequent court decision overturns previous court findings of public risk.

(d) The board may, upon majority vote of a quorum of its members, suspend the credentials of a regulated person without a hearing if the regulated person fails to maintain a current name and address with the board, as described in paragraph (e), while the regulated person is: (1) under board investigation, and a notice of conference has been issued by the board; (2) party to a contested case with the board; (3) party to an agreement for corrective action with the board; or (4) under a board order for disciplinary action. The suspension shall remain in effect until lifted by the board pursuant to the board's receipt of a petition from the regulated person, along with the regulated person's current name and address.

(e) A person regulated by the board shall maintain a current name and address with the board and shall notify the board in writing within 30 days of any change in name or address. If a name change only is requested, the regulated person must request revised credentials and return the current credentials to the board. The board may require the regulated person to substantiate the name change by submitting official documentation from a court of law or agency authorized under law to receive and officially record a name change. If an address change only is requested, no request for revised credentials is required. If the regulated person's current credentials have been lost, stolen, or destroyed, the person shall provide a written explanation to the board.

Subd. 2a. Effective dates. A suspension, revocation, condition, limitation, qualification, or restriction of a license or registration shall be in effect pending determination of an appeal unless the court, upon petition and for good cause shown, shall otherwise order. A revocation of a license pursuant to subdivision 1a is not appealable and shall remain in effect indefinitely.

Subd. 3. Conditions on reissued license. In its discretion, the board may restore and reissue a license to practice medicine, but as a condition thereof may impose any disciplinary or corrective measure which it might originally have imposed.

Subd. 4. **Temporary suspension of license.** In addition to any other remedy provided by law, the board may, without a hearing, temporarily suspend the license of a physician if the board finds that the physician has violated a statute or rule which the board is empowered to enforce and continued practice by the physician would create a serious risk of harm to the public. The suspension shall take effect upon written notice to the physician, specifying the statute or rule violated. The suspension shall remain in effect until the board issues a final order in the matter after a hearing. At the time it issues the suspension notice, the board shall schedule a disciplinary hearing to be held pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act. The physician shall be provided with at least 20 days' notice of any hearing held pursuant to this subdivision. The hearing shall be scheduled to begin no later than 30 days after the issuance of the suspension order.

Subd. 5. **Evidence.** In disciplinary actions alleging a violation of subdivision 1, paragraph (c) or (d), a copy of the judgment or proceeding under the seal of the court administrator or of the administrative agency which entered the same shall be admissible into evidence without further authentication and shall constitute prima facie evidence of the contents thereof.

Subd. 6. **Mental examination; access to medical data.** (a) If the board has probable cause to believe that a regulated person comes under subdivision 1, paragraph (1), it may direct the person to submit to a mental or physical examination. For the purpose of this subdivision every regulated person is deemed to have consented to submit to a mental or physical examination when directed in writing by the board and further to have waived all objections to the admissibility of the examining physicians' testimony or examination reports on the ground that the same constitute a privileged communication. Failure of a regulated person to submit to an examination when directed constitutes an admission of the allegations against the person, unless the failure was due to circumstance beyond the person's control, in which case a default and final order may be entered without the taking of testimony or presentation of evidence. A regulated person affected under this paragraph shall at reasonable intervals be given an opportunity to demonstrate that the person can resume the competent practice of the regulated profession with reasonable skill and safety to the public.

In any proceeding under this paragraph, neither the record of proceedings nor the orders entered by the board shall be used against a regulated person in any other proceeding.

(b) In addition to ordering a physical or mental examination, the board may, notwithstanding section 13.384, 144.651, or any other law limiting access to medical or other health data, obtain medical data and health records relating to a regulated person or applicant without the person's or applicant's consent if the board has probable cause to believe that a regulated person comes under subdivision 1, paragraph (1). The medical data may be requested from a provider, as defined in section 144.291, subdivision 2, paragraph (i); an insurance company; or a government agency, including the Department of Human Services and Direct Care and Treatment. A provider, insurance company, or government agency shall comply with any written request of the board under this subdivision and is not liable in any action for damages for releasing the data requested by the board if the data are released pursuant to a written request under this subdivision, unless the information is false and the provider giving the information knew, or had reason to believe, the information was false. Information obtained under this subdivision is classified as private under sections 13.01 to 13.87.

Subd. 7. **Tax clearance certificate.** (a) In addition to the provisions of subdivision 1, the board may not issue or renew a license if the commissioner of revenue notifies the board and the licensee or applicant for a license that the licensee or applicant owes the state delinquent taxes in the amount of \$500 or more. The board may issue or renew the license only if (1) the commissioner of revenue issues a tax clearance certificate and (2) the commissioner of revenue or the licensee or applicant forwards a copy of the clearance to the board. The commissioner of revenue may issue a clearance certificate only if the licensee or applicant does not owe the state any uncontested delinquent taxes.

(b) For purposes of this subdivision, the following terms have the meanings given.

(1) "Taxes" are all taxes payable to the commissioner of revenue, including penalties and interest due on those taxes.

(2) "Delinquent taxes" do not include a tax liability if (i) an administrative or court action that contests the amount or validity of the liability has been filed or served, (ii) the appeal period to contest the tax liability has not expired, or (iii) the licensee or applicant has entered into a payment agreement to pay the liability and is current with the payments.

(c) In lieu of the notice and hearing requirements of subdivision 1, when a licensee or applicant is required to obtain a clearance certificate under this subdivision, a contested case hearing must be held if the licensee or applicant requests a hearing in writing to the commissioner of revenue within 30 days of the date of the notice provided in paragraph (a). The hearing must be held within 45 days of the date the commissioner of revenue refers the case to the Office of Administrative Hearings. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the licensee or applicant must be served with 20 days' notice in writing specifying the time and place of the hearing and the allegations against the licensee or applicant. The notice may be served personally or by mail.

(d) The board shall require all licensees or applicants to provide their Social Security number and Minnesota business identification number on all license applications. Upon request of the commissioner of revenue, the board must provide to the commissioner of revenue a list of all licensees and applicants, including the name and address, Social Security number, and business identification number. The commissioner of revenue may request a list of the licensees and applicants no more than once each calendar year.

Subd. 8. **Limitation.** A board review or investigation of a regulated person must not be initiated unless the board has received a complaint or report within seven years from the date of the commission of some portion of the conduct complained of or reported on except for alleged violations of subdivision 1, paragraph (t).

Since 2019, the IMLCC has collected and analyzed data on new, full, unrestricted physician licenses issued by its member-state medical licensing boards. The data presented in this report compares licenses issued through the IMLCC process with the total number of new licenses issued by each member-board. Together, these figures provide insight into the growing use of the IMLCC process and its role in facilitating physician licensure across the U.S.

There are three measures presented in these reports:

- **“Initial Licenses Reported as Issued — Total”** - This number represents the total number of new, full, unrestricted physician licenses reported as issued by all U.S. physician licensing boards, including both IMLCC member and non-member boards.
- **“Initial Licenses Issued via the IMLCC Pathway”** - This represents the number of total licenses that were issued via the IMLCC process.
- **“Percentage of Initial Licenses Issued via the IMLCC Pathway”** - This percentage is arrived at by dividing the number of IMLCC Pathway licenses issued by the total number of licenses issued.

This year’s study provides a more complete picture of physician licensure across the country. In previous years, non-member states were represented collectively as “All Boards.” For the Year 9 study, data from individual member and non-member boards have been incorporated, providing a broader view of new physician licenses issued in 2025. IMLCC member-boards accounted for 83.5% of all new licenses issued in 2025.

The data also demonstrates how significantly the IMLCC process has grown as a national pathway to physician licensure:

- In 2019, 10.00% of all new licenses were issued through the IMLCC process via 24 Member-Jurisdictions.
- In 2025, 41.03% of all new licenses were issued through the IMLCC process via 36 Member-Jurisdictions.

Behind these numbers is a less visible, but equally important, change: **a shift in perception.** In the early years of the IMLCC, much of our work focused on demonstrating the value of the Compact process to state medical boards and physicians. Over time—and particularly during the past year—the conversation has evolved. The IMLCC process is increasingly viewed not simply as an alternative pathway to licensure, **but as an important tool for making qualified physicians available to more patients.**

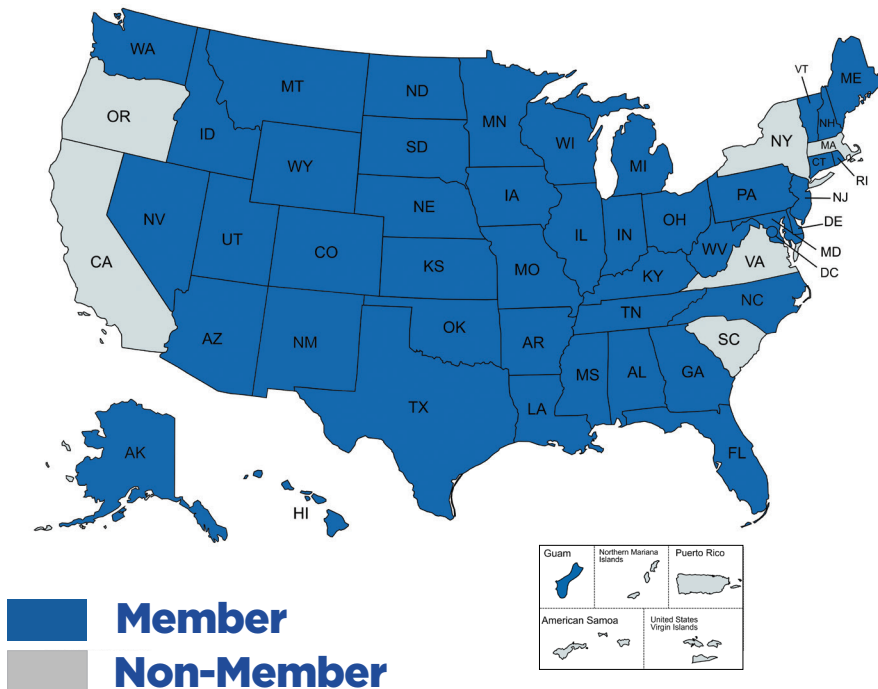
Every state that has joined the IMLCC and implemented the process has found new and innovative ways to use it to expand access to care. No one has all the answers to address the physician shortages, the needs of rural and underserved areas, and how to ensure that everyone in the US has access to the care they need, but I do know that the IMLCC will continue to provide the tools necessary for physicians, hospitals, clinics, and patients to find the answers.

The IMLCC has already changed the way physicians are licensed in the United States. As this Data Study demonstrates, that change is accelerating. We will continue to improve the Compact process, strengthen its value to participating states, and ensure that it remains a high-quality, efficient pathway for physicians to expand access to care.

**ORDER OF
INDEFINITE SUSPENSION**

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice (“Board”) is authorized pursuant Minnesota Statutes sections 147.001 through 147.381 (2026) to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, petition, or hold licenses to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes sections 214.10 and 214.103 (2026) to review and investigate complaints against persons who hold licenses to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota;

WHEREAS, Roger J. Day, M.D. (“Respondent”) has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board, from which he holds a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 6, the Board may direct a regulated person to submit to a mental or physical examination if the Board has probable cause to believe the regulated person is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of illness; intoxication; use of drugs, narcotics, chemicals, or any other type of substance; mental condition; physical condition; diminished cognitive ability; loss of motor skills; or deterioration through the aging process;

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2026, the Board served upon Respondent an Order for Mental Examination¹ (“2026 Order”), pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 6, upon probable cause to believe Respondent is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of mental illness under Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1(l). The 2026 Order directed Respondent in writing to submit to a comprehensive neuropsychological evaluation, contact the evaluator within five days of service of the 2026 Order, and make arrangements for the evaluation to be initiated at the earliest available date;

WHEREAS, Respondent has failed to submit to a comprehensive neuropsychological evaluation, as directed by the 2026 Order, and that this failure was not due to circumstance beyond Respondent’s control; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 6, failure of the regulated person to submit to an evaluation as directed, unless the failure was due to circumstances beyond the person’s control, constitutes an admission of the allegations against the regulated person, and the Board may enter a default and final order without taking testimony or allowing further evidence to be presented;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY FINDS the following Facts are deemed admitted by virtue of Respondent’s noncompliance with the 2026 Order, and that such failure was not due to circumstances beyond Respondent’s control, and finds that Respondent is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of mental illness, thereby constituting default and grounds for disciplinary action under Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1(l) as follows:

1. On September 15, 1990, Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in Minnesota.

2. In February 2024, Respondent disclosed on his renewal application that he had entered a plea of not guilty to a charge of misdemeanor trespassing in Washington County, Minnesota. On August 19, 2024, the Washington County District Court issued an Order for Competency Evaluation and Appointment of Forensic Navigator Under Minnesota Statutes section 611.42 and Minnesota Rule of Criminal Procedure 20.01 (“2024 Order for Evaluation”). On March 4, 2025, the Washington County District Court held a hearing on the 2024 Order for Evaluation and found that Respondent was incompetent and not able to assist in his defense.

ORDER

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent’s license to practice medicine in the State of Minnesota is **SUSPENDED** indefinitely. During the period of suspension, Respondent must not engage in the practice of medicine as defined by Minnesota Statutes section 147.081, subdivision 3, in the State of Minnesota, and must not use any abbreviation or other designation tending to imply licensure as a medical doctor pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 147.082.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent’s medical license will be reinstated when Respondent demonstrates Respondent is able to resume the competent practice of medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients. In order to demonstrate Respondent’s ability to safely practice medicine, Respondent must provide any relevant information reasonably requested by the Complaint Review Committee (“Committee”) of the Board, and Respondent may be required to meet with the Committee to review Respondent’s health status and plans for practice. Evidence

of Respondent's ability to safely practice medicine may include, but not be limited to, obtaining an evaluation equivalent to the evaluation originally required by the 2026 Order.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that when Respondent presents evidence of Respondent's ability to resume the competent practice of medicine, the Board may reinstate Respondent's license, subject to Respondent's June 17, 2005 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order, or may continue the suspension of Respondent's license if Respondent has failed to demonstrate Respondent is able to resume the competent practice of medicine with reasonable skill and safety.

**ORDER FOR MENTAL
EXAMINATION**

Roger Jerome Day, M.D., ("Respondent") has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota.

Respondent has been advised by Board representatives that he may choose to be represented by legal counsel in this matter. Although aware of this opportunity, Respondent has elected not to be represented by counsel. The Minnesota Board of Medical Practice ("Board") Complaint Review Committee was represented by Carlos Figari, Assistant Attorney General, 445 Minnesota Street, Suite 600, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101.

STATUTES

1. The Minnesota Board of Medical Practice ("Board") is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 147.001 through 147.381 (2024) to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, petition, or hold licenses to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 214.10 and 214.103 (2024) to review and investigate complaints against persons who hold licenses to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota.

2. If the Board has probable cause to believe a regulated person engaged in conduct that is grounds for disciplinary action under Minn. Stat. § 147.091, subd. 1, paragraph (1) (inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of substance use, mental illness, or physical illness), the Board may direct the person to submit to a mental or physical examination under Minn. Stat. § 147.091, subd. 6. When so directed by the Board in writing, every regulated person is deemed to have consented to the examination and to have waived all objections to the admissibility of the examiner's testimony or reports on the grounds that the communications were privileged. *Id.*

3. Failure of a regulated person to submit to an examination when directed constitutes an admission of the allegations against the person, unless the failure was due to circumstance beyond the person's control, in which case a default and final order may be entered without the taking of testimony or presentation of evidence. Minn. Stat. § 147.091, subd. 6(a). The regulated person bears the burden of proving a circumstance beyond his or her control by a preponderance of the evidence.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

4. The Board has probable cause to believe that Respondent is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of mental illness, based on the following:

a. On September 15, 1990, Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in Minnesota.

b. In February 2024, Respondent disclosed on his renewal application that he had entered a plea of not guilty to a charge of misdemeanor trespassing in Washington County, Minnesota. On August 19, 2024, the Washington County District Court issued an

Order for Competency Evaluation and Appointment of Forensic Navigator Under Minn. Stat. § 611.42 and Minn. R. Crim. P. 20.01 (“2024 Order for Evaluation”). On March 4, 2025, the Washington County District Court held a hearing in which it found that Respondent was incompetent and not able to assist in his defense.

5. Respondent’s conduct set forth above constitutes probable cause for the Board to believe that that Respondent is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of substance use or a mental or physical condition. Under such circumstances, the Board may direct Respondent to submit to a comprehensive mental health evaluation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 147, subdivision 6.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Under the Minnesota Data Practices Act, Minn. Ch. 13, information given to the Board evaluator as part of an active investigation of a licensed health professional is confidential. Confidential investigative information is for the Board to use to evaluate the allegations made against Respondent as set forth above. If the information provided during the evaluation shows that Respondent is in violation of a statute or rule that the Board enforces, the Board’s Complaint Review Committee may recommend that disciplinary action be taken by the Board against Respondent’s license. If this matter proceeds to a contested case hearing before an independent administrative law judge, the information in the evaluation could become public.

2. Refusal to provide information to the evaluator pursuant to this Order may result in a charge that Respondent failed to comply with a Board order under Minn. Stat. § 147.091, subd. 1(f) or failed to cooperate with the Board’s investigation as required by Minn. Stat. § 147.131, either of which may constitute an independent basis for disciplinary action by the Board.

3. In accordance with statutes and rules governing the Board's legal processes, information received during the evaluation may be disclosed to other persons including staff of the Board and the Office of the Attorney General. It may be released to other persons and/or governmental entities who have statutory authority to review the data, investigate specific conduct and/or take appropriate legal action, including but not limited to law enforcement agencies, courts and other regulatory agencies. If the Board institutes a formal disciplinary action against Respondent that is litigated, the information supplied could become public.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent shall submit to a comprehensive neuropsychological evaluation with Michael J. Fuhrman, Ph.D., Midwestern Neuropsychology, 10125 Crosstown Circle, Suite 105, Eden Prairie, Minnesota, 55344. The nature, scope and duration of the evaluation are to be determined by Dr. Fuhrman. Respondent must contact Dr. Fuhrman at 952-928-9003 within five days of service of this Order, to make arrangements for the evaluation to be initiated at the earliest available date. The evaluation results are to be transmitted directly by Dr. Fuhrman to Elizabeth Huntley, Executive Director, Minnesota Board of Medical Practice. The evaluation will be at the Board's expense.

 - a. Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota on June 10, 2021. Respondent is board certified in orthopedic surgery.
 - b. On his March 2024 license renewal application, Respondent reported that his employment was terminated without cause in December 2023. Respondent was issued a Corrective Action Plan ("CAP") and a written warning in October 2021 based on Respondent's

behavior and demeanor towards staff and colleagues, including making inappropriate racial and sexual comments. There were also concerns related to his treatment and care of a patient ("Patient #1") who required urgent surgical care four weeks post-operatively following a total knee replacement performed by Respondent on August 28, 2023.

c. On January 22, 2026, Respondent appeared before the Committee to discuss the allegations. Respondent stated that he saw Patient #1 in his office on September 27, 2023, which was the day Patient #1 was discharged from the hospital and two days after she had presented in the emergency department with a painful and swollen knee after a recent fall at home. Patient #1's attending hospital physician spoke with Respondent and notified him that Patient #1 had an abnormally high white blood cell count. Respondent acknowledged that he had access to Patient #1's records from her hospital stay, but does not recall reviewing the records. During Respondent's office visit with Patient #1 on September 27, 2023, Respondent noted that Patient #1 had symptoms of hemarthrosis he attributed to her fall. Respondent did not document whether he reviewed records from Patient #1's hospital stay, did not recommend Patient #1 undergo further evaluation or diagnostic testing, and failed to consider infection as a differential diagnosis despite Patient #1 having a painful swollen knee and an elevated white blood cell count. Respondent acknowledged there were steps he should have taken to rule out the possibility of a significant infection under the circumstances, including performing an aspiration for synovial fluid culture and sensitivity and checking for inflammatory markers. Patient #1 returned to the emergency department on September 30, 2023, with additional symptoms of sepsis.

d. With respect to allegations regarding Respondent's behavior and demeanor, Respondent stated that he changed his interactions with coworkers, especially in the operating room, after receiving feedback from his former employer. Documentation indicated that

complaints about Respondent's demeanor and behavior continued after Respondent received feedback, but Respondent denied recollections of the specific events that raised concern with colleagues. Respondent acknowledged that workplace professionalism needs to be maintained at all times.

2. Based on the discussion, the Committee views Respondent's conduct as inappropriate under Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1 (g) (engaged in unethical or improper conduct) and (k) (engaged in conduct that departs from or fails to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing medical practice in which case proof of actual injury need not be established) (2024), and Respondent agrees that the conduct cited above constitutes a reasonable basis in law and fact to justify corrective action under these statutes.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

3. Respondent agrees to address the concerns referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 by taking the following corrective action:

a. Within nine months of the date of the Agreement, Respondent shall successfully complete pre-approved coursework in:

- i. Professional Boundaries;
- ii. Professional Communication; and
- iii. Management of Post-Operative Joint Replacements.

b. Within three months of successful completion of the above-referenced coursework, he shall write and submit a paper, for review and approval by the Committee, discussing what he has learned from the coursework and how he will implement this knowledge into his practice; and

c. This Agreement shall be satisfied upon Respondent's successful completion of the terms of the Agreement.

4. This Agreement shall become effective upon execution by the Committee and shall remain in effect until Respondent successfully completes the terms of the Agreement. Successful completion shall be determined by the Committee. Upon Respondent's signature and the Committee's execution of this Agreement, the Committee agrees to close the complaints resulting in the information referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2. Respondent understands and further agrees that if, after the matter has been closed, the Committee receives additional complaints similar to the information in paragraphs 1 and 2, the Committee may reopen the closed complaint.

5. If Respondent fails to satisfy the terms of the Agreement the Committee may, in its discretion, reopen the investigation and proceed according to Minnesota Statutes chapters 14, 147, and 214. Failure to satisfy the terms of the Agreement constitutes failure to cooperate under Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1(u). In any subsequent proceeding, the Committee may use this Agreement as proof that Respondent's conduct, cited in the Facts above, justified action under these statutes.

6. Respondent understands that this Agreement does not constitute disciplinary action. Respondent further understands and acknowledges that this Agreement and any letter of satisfaction are classified as public data for purposes of Minnesota Statutes sections 13.02, subdivision 15, and 13.41, subdivision 5 (2024). Data regarding this Agreement may be provided to data banks as required by federal law or consistent with Board policy.

7. Respondent acknowledges reading and understanding this Agreement and entering into it voluntarily. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the Committee and

Respondent, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this Agreement.

**AGREEMENT FOR
CORRECTIVE ACTION**

This Agreement for Corrective Action (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between Wojciech Tadeusz Zukowski, M.D. (“Respondent”), and the Complaint Review Committee of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice (“Committee”) pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statutes section 214.103, subdivision 6(a) (2026). Respondent has been advised by Board representatives that he may choose to be represented by legal counsel in this matter. Respondent elected to be represented by Ryan Ellis, Lind Jensen Sullivan & Peterson, P.A., 901 Marquette Avenue South, Suite 1900, Minneapolis, Minnesota 55402. The Committee was represented by Carlos Figari, Assistant Attorney General, 445 Minnesota Street, Suite 600, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101. Respondent and the Committee hereby agree as follows:

FACTS

1. For the purpose of this Agreement, the Board may consider the following facts as true:

a. Respondent was licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota on September 6, 2003. Respondent is board certified in internal medicine.

b. In August 2025, the Board received a complaint alleging that Respondent touched a patient (“Patient #1”) without explaining the medical necessity and without her consent

during an office visit. During the course of the investigation, it was revealed that another patient (“Patient #2”) had previously submitted a similar complaint regarding Respondent’s conduct.

c. On June 1, 2026, Respondent appeared before the Committee to discuss the allegations. Respondent stated that patients were given the option of having a chaperone in the room during their office visit following Patient #2’s complaint. Respondent further stated that he did not offer Patient #1 a chaperone because he assumed based on her age that she did not want a chaperone. Respondent acknowledged that his practice was out of step with patient expectations and that every patient should be offered a chaperone. Respondent admitted that he did not clearly communicate to Patient #2 what he was doing when he lowered her gown and performed her cardiac examination.

2. Based on the discussion, the Committee views Respondent’s conduct as inappropriate under Minnesota Statutes section 147.091, subdivision 1 (k) (engaged in conduct that departs from or fails to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing medical practice in which case proof of actual injury need not be established) (2026), and Respondent agrees that the conduct cited above constitutes a reasonable basis in law and fact to justify corrective action under these statutes.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

3. Respondent agrees to address the concerns referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 by taking the following corrective action:

a. Within six months of the date of the Agreement, Respondent shall successfully complete pre-approved coursework in:

- i. Boundaries pertaining to the doctor/patient relationship; and
- ii. Patient Communication.

b. Within three months of successful completion of the above-referenced coursework, he shall write and submit a paper, for review and approval by the Committee, discussing what he has learned from the coursework and how he will implement this knowledge into his practice; and

c. This Agreement shall be satisfied upon Respondent's successful completion of the terms of the Agreement.

4. This Agreement shall become effective upon execution by the Committee and shall remain in effect until Respondent successfully completes the terms of the Agreement. Successful completion shall be determined by the Committee. Upon Respondent's signature and the Committee's execution of this Agreement, the Committee agrees to close the complaints resulting in the information referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2. Respondent understands and further agrees that if, after the matter has been closed, the Committee receives additional complaints similar to the information in paragraphs 1 and 2, the Committee may reopen the closed complaint.

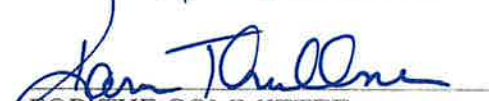
