

# WE'RE MOVING TO A SINGLE SALON LICENSE TYPE

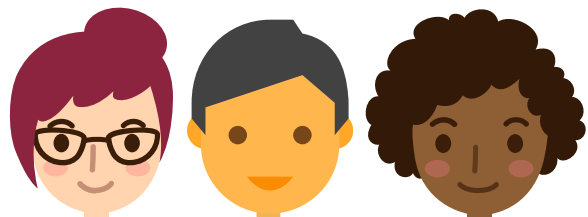
## HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

### WHAT?



Instead of having three specific salon license types (cosmetologist, esthetician and nail technician), salons will carry a **"Salon License"** with no specific service-type designation.

### WHO?

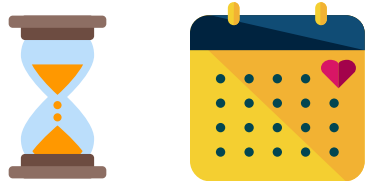


**This change affects everyone.**

Your personal license type determines what types of services you can offer in the salon; salon licenses will no longer limit the services an establishment may offer, only your personal license will.

With this change, any actively licensed salon manager can be the Designated Licensed Salon Manager of a salon.

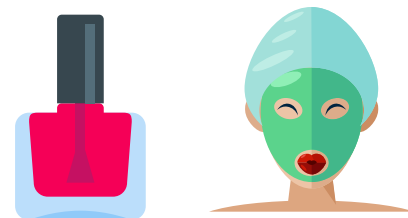
### WHEN?

**If you already have a salon license, we'll make the switch for you.**

If you are opening a salon now which will be offering nail and skin care services, you may apply for one salon license. That license will change to an all-encompassing salon license in January.
