**ORDER OF REMOVAL OF
STAY OF SUSPENSION**

This matter came before the Complaint Review Panel of the Minnesota Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board (“Board”) in accordance with the terms of a Stipulation and Consent Order (“2015 Stipulation”), which Wanda R. Smith, EMT (“Respondent”), agreed to and signed on October 30, 2015.

Pursuant to the 2015 Stipulation, Respondent’s emergency medical technician certification was suspended, but the suspension was stayed contingent upon Respondent’s compliance with all terms and conditions set forth in the 2015 Stipulation. In paragraph 7 of the 2015 Stipulation, Respondent agreed that the Complaint Review Panel is authorized to issue an Order of Removal of Stay of Suspension (“Order of Removal”) if it has probable cause to believe Respondent violated any of the requirements for staying the suspension of Respondent’s certification in the 2015 Stipulation.

The Complaint Review Panel has probable cause to believe Respondent violated one or more of the requirements for staying the suspension of Respondent’s certification in the 2015 Stipulation.

ORDER

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stay of suspension set forth in the 2015 Stipulation is **REMOVED**, and the certification of Respondent as an emergency medical technician in the State of Minnesota is **SUSPENDED** immediately.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's certification as an emergency medical technician in the State of Minnesota shall remain suspended until the Board makes a final determination in this matter.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's violation of this Order shall provide grounds for further disciplinary action pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 144E.28, subdivision 5(1).

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board shall conduct a hearing pursuant to paragraphs 12 and 13 of the 2015 Stipulation. After that hearing, the Board may take any of the following actions:

a. Dismiss the Complaint Review Panel's allegations and reinstate Respondent's certification under the terms of the 2015 Stipulation.


b. Reinstate Respondent's certification with limitations placed upon the scope of Respondent's practice and/or conditional upon further reports to the Board.

c. Continue the suspension of Respondent's certification.

d. Impose any other form of discipline permitted by Minnesota Statutes section 144E.28, subdivisions 4 and 5.
