Priority Activities

- Review and re-assess CEOC plan to reach audiences, partners, consumers
- Ensure compliance with licensing standards

- Evaluate and re-assess plan

Priority Activities

- Streamline internal business processes
- Implement new licensing system and continuous process improvement
- Evaluate technology activities, processes, including policy and budget issues
- Implementation of new and enhanced technology

Priority Activities

- Develop FY 2018—FY 2019 biennial budget with possible fee increase
- Work to repeal social worker licensing exemption; clarify use of social work title in county agencies
- Conduct in-depth review of Practice Act to examine relevance; licensure portability and practice mobility; and technology standards
