Rulemaking authority and other relevant statutes:	Expedited Rules 2016 Session Law Chapter 189 Article 13 Section 68: The Board of Barber Examiners may use expedited rulemaking procedures under Minnesota Statutes, section 14.389, to amend Minnesota Rules, chapter 2100, to conform with sections 29 to 52 and sections 69 and 70.
